MESSAGE FROM FR STINNETT

THE BLESSED TRINITY – ONE GOD IN THREE PERSONS

Many theologians down the ages have tried to develop new ways of understanding the Blessed Trinity. At the outset, though, we have to admit that this central mystery of our faith is something that will always remain outside the complete grasp of minds in this life. Our finite minds are not capable of grasping the totality of the Infinite, so we are incapable of fully grasping the totality of God. This, however, is a good thing. If we were to be capable of grasping the full mystery of the Trinity, of One God in Three Persons, then we would lose the awe and adoration we have for God. He would no longer stand in majesty over and above us, and we would not turn to Him with the faith and trust that He deserves. If we were to understand God in His mystery, we would be His equal. When the archangel Lucifer tried this, he ended up becoming God's rival. The inaccessible mystery of the Trinity preserves the order of the being, and it keeps us in a place where God is able to be a help to us.

The mystery of the Trinity may not be fully grasped by our minds, but it is not our knowledge of God that saves us, it is our love for Him, or rather, His love for us. Most of us do not have the necessary philosophical and theological training to make much sense of the distinctions within the Blessed Trinity, but that does not mean we cannot love the Blessed Trinity. Our hearts are informed by our mind, but they are not limited by it.

We are still in the month of May, a month dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. She can be a model for us of the great love we are to have of the Trinity. Mary has a unique relationship with the Trinity. Like all of us, she is a daughter of the Father. But unlike the rest of us, she is the Mother of the Son of God, and she is the spouse of the Holy Spirit. Mary's entire life is immersed in her relationship with the Trinity. It is her relationship with them that defines her life, both here on earth and forever in Heaven. Pope St John Paul II said this of Mary's relationship with the Trinity: "Everything comes from the will of the Father, Who has sent His Son into the world, revealing Him to men and establishing Him as Head of the Church and the center of history. This plan was fulfilled by the Incarnation, the work of the Holy Spirit, but with the essential cooperation of a woman, the Virgin Mary. She thus became an integral part in the economy of communicating the Trinity to the human race."

Sometimes it is easier for us to approach Mary, because she is merely human like us. She can bring us into the throne room of God, to teach us to love and adore Him. While our limited minds cannot comprehend God completely, Mary shows us that we are still able to say "Yes" to Him, to respond to His love for us, and to approach Him with trust and worship. This is the path of salvation for us, the path of love that Mary and the saints have walked before us. So even if "One God in Three Persons" seems like word salad, we can still say with our hearts, "I love You, O my God!"

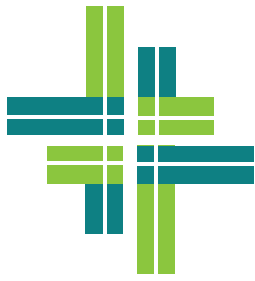
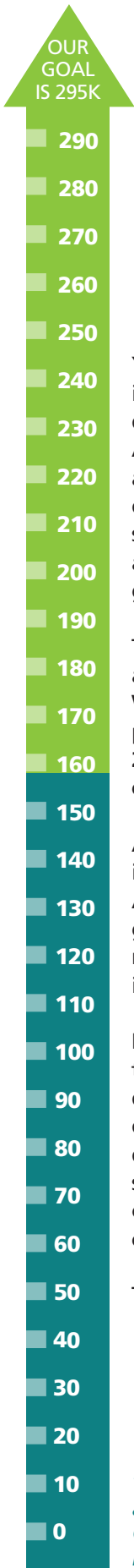

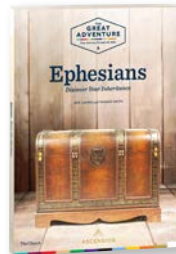
