# A MESSAGE FROM KARA DAY



#### STOP HIDING IN SIN & WALK IN THE LIGHT

Today's Responsorial Psalm reads "With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption." As I reflect on today's readings, I am in awe of the Lord's mercy that He offers us time and time again. The first reading from Genesis details the aftermath of the Fall, and how Adam and Eve were afraid so they hid themselves

from God. Then, the voice of our loving Father asks, "Where are you?" God, the Father, invites us to come out of hiding in our sin and walk in the light to receive His fullness of redemption and mercy! My encouragement to us this week is to return to the Sacrament of Confession. Whether it has been a couple of weeks, months, or several years, Jesus is waiting for you in the Sacrament to extend His love and mercy to you. St Brendan's Confession times are: Wednesdays, 6-7 PM (during Adoration) and Saturdays, 9 AM (or by appointment.)

Going to Confession can feel intimidating at times. Below are some testimonies from our Vine High Schoolers regarding Confession:

"About 2 years ago, I made a commitment to go to Confession on a weekly basis. At first, I felt a little scared that the priest was going to judge me and dissect my character based on the sins I was confessing to. I later realized that this is not true as the priest is acting in the person of Christ and Christ wants to forgive, not condemn! After a while, I became more open to the love of God! I now live in a freedom that I can't even begin to explain!" ~ Lily, junior

"...the more you do it, the less you fear your sins and the more you can't wait for God's forgiveness. In Confession, like in anything, the more you put into it, the more you get out. The more time you spend examining your conscience and the more you open your heart, the more God will come in with His mercy and grace! He wants to pour out His forgiveness, but will you allow Him?" ~Austin, sophomore

"Confession helped me to see a new side of God that I hadn't known before. I learned how much God loves us, and how much He desires to tear down the walls that are trying to separate us from Him. Confession also taught me how to be vulnerable by admitting 'Jesus, I've messed up bad and I don't want to keep living my life like this.' ~Katie, sophomore

"I used to be very anxious and afraid when I would go to Confession. But, I realized that we have a loving Father who is merciful and just wants to forgive us, not judge us, and that the priest is called to imitate this. This understanding helped me a lot, to stop fearing how I would be perceived. Another thing that helped was going to Confession more often. I found that the more I go, the easier it becomes to keep going and the better my prayer life becomes, because I have less sin coming between me and God. If you haven't been to Confession in a while, I would encourage you to come back. It is an amazing feeling to be absolved from your sins and it really does impact both your physical and spiritual life. It will be hard your first time back but I promise you, it will be worth it!" ~Kyle, senior

# ST MOTHER TERESA'S REFLECTION ON ADORATION OF JESUS IN THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT – PART 2

Eucharistic Adoration offers to our people the opportunity to join those in religious life to pray for the salvation of the world, souls everywhere and peace on earth. We cannot underestimate the power of prayer and the difference it will make in our world. Jesus has made Himself the Bread of Life to give us life. Night and day, He is there.

If you really want to grow in love, come back to the Eucharist, come back to that Adoration. Our hours of Adoration will be special hours of reparation for sins, and intercession for the needs of the whole world, exposing the sin-sick and suffering humanity to the healing, sustaining and transforming rays of Jesus, radiating from the Eucharist. Each one of us is a coworker of Christ – we must labor hard to carry Him to the hearts where He has not yet been known and loved... But, unless we have Jesus, we cannot give Him; that is why we need the Eucharist. Spend as much time as possible in front of the Blessed Sacrament and He will fill you with His strength and power.

Eucharistic Adoration is the most beautiful thing you could ever think of doing. People are hungry for God. Imagine for a moment that we are living in Jesus' time and He has invited us to visit with Him and spend some quiet time getting to know Him better. Being aware of who He was, we would be humbled and honored by such an invitation. The good news is that Jesus is here with us TODAY – body, blood, soul and divinity – in the Holy Eucharist. Although Jesus comes to us under the appearance of bread and wine, His presence is as real to us NOW as He was flesh-and-blood-real to His disciples when He walked this earth. He can perform miracles, heal us, teach us, and love us. We can talk to Him and He can speak to us through His Word and through the Holy Spirit who lives in us through our Baptism and Confirmation.

Jesus has made Himself the Bread of Life to give us life. Night and day, He is there. If you really want to grow in love, come back to the Eucharist, come back to that Adoration.
