# **MESSAGE FROM DEACON JIM**

#### THE TRADITION OF RELICS CONTAINED WITHIN CATHOLIC ALTARS...

Every year I have the opportunity to work with the Cub Scouts/Boy Scouts of our St Brendan Pack/Troop on their Religious Awards Programs. One of the things we usually do is tour the Church. A couple years ago someone asked if the altar had relics in it. It does – two in fact – and the altar in the Adoration Chapel has one. I thought it might be of interest to share some information about those particular relics and relics in general with you.

First, a bit about relics – Relics of saints are objects or remains of religious significance that are preserved as memorials to saints. The word "relic" comes from the Latin word reliquiae, meaning "remaining" or "that which remains." The Catholic Church classifies relics into three types:

- First class Body parts of a saint, such as bones, blood, or hair, as well as objects directly associated with Christ, like the true cross
- Second class Objects that came into direct contact with the saint while they were alive, such as their clothing or personal possessions
- Third class Items that have touched a first or second class relic, or that the saint has touched themselves

The tradition of having relics contained within consecrated Catholic altars is an ancient tradition from the very earliest days of the Church. When Catholicism was still illegal under the Roman Empire, early members of the Faithful would meet in underground catacombs to escape harsh persecution. They would celebrate Mass on the stone slabs covering the tombs of martyrs to show proper reverence for the ultimate sacrifice they made for Christ.

When Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity, Mass no longer needed to be held underground out of necessity. Moving above ground, they didn't leave behind the tradition of venerating the relics of saints. Churches were generally built over the remains of martyrs, but when not possible, a first-class relic was placed within the altar and covered by a stone slab. The Second Council of Nicaea would later decree that all churches were to have altars containing relics of saints. Eventually, the practice became ecclesiastical law, with early editions of the Roman Pontifical mandating altars to contain first-class relics from two separate saints, one of which a martyr.

According to "St Brendan Church History: The first Fifty Years of St Brendan Catholic Church of Hilliard, Ohio" published in 2006, the main altar contains relics from two second century saints – Florentius and Aurelius. The Adoration Chapel altar contains a relic of St Pius X. All three relics were provided by the Diocese. So, when the priest kisses the altar at the beginning of Mass, he is not only showing reverence for Jesus Christ as the literal cornerstone of the Church as the altar represents, but also continues the ancient tradition of showing reverence for the sacrifice of the martyrs.

This practice serves as a continual reminder to us that when we participate in the celebration of Mass, we are celebrating with all the

saints and angels in Heaven. "When he broke open the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar\* the souls of those who had been slaughtered because of the witness they bore to the word of God." – Revelation 6:9

Just another example of how rich (and frankly, cool) our Catholic Church is. May God bless you, protect you from all evil and bring you to eternal life! ~ Deacon Jim


This progress chart shows dollar amounts in increments of \$10,000. Our pledge amount reached so far is shown in the darker teal color.
