## A MESSAGE FROM JEN RICE

#### DON'T LET THIS OPPORTUNITY TO ENCOUNTER JESUS PASS YOU BY!

As Jesus was leaving Jericho with His disciples and a sizable crowd, Bartimaeus, a blind man, sat by the roadside begging. On hearing that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me!" And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he kept calling out all the more, "Son of David, have pity on me." Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called the blind man, saying to him, "Take courage; get up. He is calling you." He threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus. (Mark 11:46-50)

What if Jesus was passing by in our town tomorrow? Would you wait by the side of the road for Him to come? Would you call out to Him in your need? Or would you stay in your house going about your usual daily business thinking, "Oh, I'll catch Him later"?

You have your chance to make that decision this week. Jesus arrives to our diocese Monday at St. Joseph in Somerset, the oldest Catholic Church in Ohio. He has been traveling to all the towns and villages along the Seton Route that began in New Haven, CT on May 17, and will make His way through Central Ohio all of this week on the way to Cincinnati, then Indianapolis for the Eucharistic Congress.

Fr Roger Landry, the chaplain at Columbia University, is leading the Seton Route. Traveling with him are two priests, one brother, one seminarian, and five young adults. The Daughters of Mary, Mother of Healing Love also accompany the procession. Along their way and on the other three routes, there are already stories of people who have been touched by the Lord on the side of the road: a Protestant man who had just opened his Bible and prayed for the first time in years ran after the procession, wanting to follow all the way to Indianapolis. A woman who isn't able to walk has been joining each procession along the St Juan Diego Route since Brownsville, Texas, on a retrofitted tricycle. Also in Texas, some perpetual pilgrims helped bandage a woman's wounded leg at a homeless shelter, and then the woman whose name is Hope — asked the pilgrims to pray with her. A man in Oregon drove to the middle of nowhere just to witness the procession, got out of his truck and knelt down as Jesus passed by. Construction workers in New York City move their equipment and stop their work to allow the procession to move through.

We are blessed to be here in this time, in this place, for a moment like this – where Jesus will pass through our midst, when we can kneel before Him in adoration, gratitude, but also in hope. And while we are able to have Jesus with us in our tabernacle and on our altars each day,



this is truly a moment that will not likely occur again for some time. I encourage you to look at the schedule to the right, choose one of the events, register and go! Take courage, get up, Jesus is calling you! Throw off whatever you are doing and go wait for Him as He passes by. Bartimaeus asked to see. Let us all ask to truly "see" Jesus present in our midst so that we may be fortified for our own journeys. Don't let this opportunity pass you by. I'll see you on the road. ~ Jennifer Rice

Jb 38:1, 8-11 | 2 Cor 5:14-17 | Mk 4:35-41

#### **GROW** AS A DISCIPLE | pray, study, engage, serve

St. Boniface, an English Benedictine monk who died in the 8th century, wrote in a letter: "In her voyage across the ocean of this world, the Church is like a great ship being pounded by the waves of life's different stresses. Our duty is not to abandon ship but to keep her on her course," Oceans and seas, lakes and rivers. baptism. The role of water in daily life and its use as a metaphor are woven throughout our Scriptures. In today's readings, we hear two references to the sea. First, we have God talking to Job out of a storm, reminding the prophet that he - the Lord - is the one who created the seas and keeps them firmly in their place. The Gospel passage provides us with a stark reminder of that truth. As the disciples and Jesus cross the sea, a storm crops up and threatens to sink their boat. But one command from Jesus and the water is still. St. Boniface had it right. We really all are on that ship with Jesus on its voyage across the ocean of this world, and trusting in him to keep us on course and safe from harm ensures we reach the destinations he intends for us.

#### **GO** EVANGELIZE

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

How to do our part to keep this great ship that is the Church on course? Trust in Christ, trust that he is present within us and guiding us each day. No one is immune from stormy seas, and like the disciples, we can turn to Jesus in times of peril. He asked the disciples: "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?" Like the disciples, we must experience the change of heart that is necessary to place complete trust in Jesus to replace our fear and anxiety. God has things under control. Of course, that is what can be so scarv sometimes. I know God will take care of everything. but what if I don't like how he does it? What if I want him to answer my prayers one way and he answers them a different way? This is where Jesus might ask me: "Do you not yet have faith?" And I would have to reply, "I'm working on it."

**PRAY** We are assured throughout Scripture that God loves us, cares for us, and sustains us. But how do we move from knowing that in our heads to feeling it in our hearts? Prayer. If we center our life on Jesus and his commands, trusting in him will become second nature. Take some time this week and pray with today's Psalm (107:23-24, 25-26, 28-29, 30-31), which praises God for his love for us and gives voice to trusting in his providence.
