A MESSAGE FROM JACOB DORAN



This summer, I am taking a course about the Eucharist and Catholic Education. Going into it, I took the attitude that I already know all the basics – I can give you evidence from the Bible, define transubstantiation, and even recite the effects of the Sacrament. However, I quickly realized that I, in fact, was too "thin" in my understanding of the Eucharist.

In the very first reading assignment, the reality of the Eucharist expanded for me. I thought that the Blessed Sacrament was something mostly limited to the Mass. What I came to know is that our every action, thought, and intention can be offered along with the bread and wine at the altar. Remember the phrase "offer it up"? Well, through all those opportunities for sacrifice in our lives, we are meant to bring with us and consciously give them to God in the Mass. A life powered by the Eucharist isn't meant to start at the ding of the bell but is supposed to be something we are always mindful of, preparing ourselves continually for, the act of sacrifice that is always a part of worship.

Pope Benedict XVI wrote in *Sacramentum Caritatis*: "The Eucharist, since it embraces the concrete, everyday existence of the believer, makes possible, day by day, the progressive transfiguration of all those called by grace to reflect the image of the Son of God. There is nothing authentically human – our thoughts and affections, our words and deeds – that does not find in the sacrament of the Eucharist the form it needs to be lived to the full."

Not only can we bring every moment of our lives to God, but the Eucharist empowers us to bring God to every moment of our lives. Try to be attuned in every joy and difficulty that you celebrate or sacrifice like Christ because of the gift and power of the Eucharist. Each day of life is then a flowing out from and back to Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. ~ Jacob

HOW TO "DO" ADORATION

Why Should I Visit our Adoration Chapel?

- God often chooses the quiet and stillness to speak so we will hear Him. One of our biggest challenges in this world is the amount of noise, voices speaking at us, our own anxieties and to-do lists clouding what is the next best and right thing. Spending time in the quiet in Jesus' presence pushes out all of the noise and, with regular visits and practice, teaches us to zero in on His voice and His will.
- Carving out regular prayer time or even silent time is proven to benefit the rest of the day or reset yourself after a busy/difficult day. It also works as a transition between work and home or school and home.
- One of the greatest gifts you can "give back" to Jesus is to spend time with Him. That's all He wants – your love. Adoration shows that you value the relationship to spend time with Him outside of Mass.

How Do I "Do" Adoration?

- Ideally, sign up for a time to put in your schedule. You can go sporadically at first to get comfortable, then you can commit to a biweekly or weekly time. If you can't make it, it is easy to press a button and get a sub. Go to stbrendan.weadorehim.com to sign up, see the schedule, pick your time.
- When you arrive, please check in! The fuller our chapel is, the more hours we can add in the future. 10 seconds of your time means more hours for all!
- Genuflect, then find a seat. Kneel or sit. Now you have an hour to "be" in however the Spirit is moving you that day. Some suggestions (handouts also available in the chapel):
 - † Thank God for all of the blessings that week.
 - † Pray for your intentions and for those who have asked you to pray for them.
 - † Meditate in silence on the crucifix or any of the sacred art.
 - † Read Scripture or another spiritual book
 - † Journal
 - † Pray the Rosary
 - † Just sit, rest and receive. Open your hands on your lap. Breathe deeply. It is OK if you drift. You are at peace!
 - † If outside thoughts distract you, simply acknowledge it, then watch it float by – you can deal with it later.
- Bring a friend, commit and pray together.

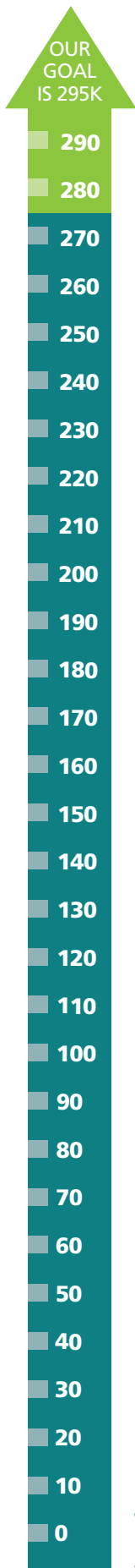

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured." The assuredness with which the woman in today's Gospel, afflicted with hemorrhages, speaks, is something I aspire to. She is at her wit's end, with nothing to lose and everything to gain, and she simply determines what she will do, bolstered by her faith in Jesus Christ. Notice how she doesn't approach Jesus directly, engage in conversation, or even *ask* anything of him. And Jesus, for his part, doesn't actively seek her out or call her to him. But the woman *knows*. "She had heard about Jesus," and she just *knows* that by simply touching his clothing, not even touching his human flesh, that the power he has within him will cure her. Her actions reflect the virtues of fortitude and hope, but it is her faith that has allowed her to see and understand the divine nature of Jesus - to see the God of healing standing before her. And she is not afraid. She trusts in his promises and compassion, and gives herself over to him with full vulnerability, achieving healing and being granted peace in response. If only we could do the same every time we are at *our* wit's end ... or maybe even long before we get there.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

If we are to follow Jesus we're instructed to imitate him - giving people hope in situations that can seem hopeless. The promises of Christ are real, and through him God's original order for Creation is restored. Death is defeated. The sick are healed. The kingdom of God, inaugurated by Christ and in which we participate here in this life, will be brought to fullness and fruition in the next. Being people of faith doesn't mean we won't suffer or die, but it *does* mean that suffering and death don't have the last word with us. When we know and understand this, it affects our whole approach and way of relating to one another. When we know the words of Jesus *are* the truth, we take them into our hearts, live them in our actions, and share them by our witness.
