

A MESSAGE FROM FR DOOLEY

Hello friends,

I wanted to use the bulletin column this weekend to introduce myself! I am a native of St Nicholas Parish in Zanesville, where my family has been proud members of this parish community since 1888. I am a product of Catholic education from "up on the hill" as we say in Zanesville. My primary education was held at the former St Nicholas Grade School (now Bishop Fenwick Grade School). In 2006, I graduated from Bishop Rosecrans High School. My parents, Kevin and Suzanne, operated a diner in downtown Zanesville for many years. Today, they have entered a semi-retired life, but they stay active by cooking lunch for a large childcare center in Zanesville. They also coordinate the Parish School of Religion program for St Nicholas Parish. I have two younger brothers, Patrick and Dennis, who both work and live in the Zanesville area. Patrick is currently employed for Creative Packaging Incorporated. Dennis, my youngest brother, works for Genesis Hospital and he operates a small carpentry business.

Growing up, my family held prayer and the corporal works of mercy in the forefront of our lives. That call to serve Jesus Christ and others appealed to me, so I became more active in my parish through altar serving and youth ministry. My family has been blessed with a rich history of vocations which include: three Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity of Manitowoc, Wisconsin, two Dominican Friars of the St Joseph Province, and one diocesan priest, who was killed while on his way to offer Mass by the Communists in Lithuania in 1945. (Their pictures will hang proudly in my office).

After high school, I entered college seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum, graduating in 2010 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in History. My graduate course work also took place at the Josephinum. After three years of graduate studies, I took a year off and entered the workforce. During that time, I worked for American Electric Power and John Quint Treboni Funeral Home in Columbus. After some strange God moments, I returned to the seminary in the fall of 2014, and completed a Master of Divinity Degree. By the grace of God, I was ordained on May 30, 2015, by Bishop Frederick Campbell at St Paul the Apostle Parish in Westerville. I've had a unique and fascinating life as a priest – what a ride! In my first assignment, I served as the Parochial Vicar of the Four County Catholic Consortium from 2015-2019. The Consortium of Parishes included: St Peter, Chillicothe; St Colman of Cloyne, Washington Courthouse; St Mary Queen of the Missions, Waverly; and St Sylvester, Zaleski. I also served as chaplain for Bishop Flaget Grade School and for the Veterans Affairs Hospital in Chillicothe. After my time in southern Ohio, I was appointed the Pastor of Our Lady of Peace Parish and School in Beechwold and Clintonville from 2019-2024. Currently, I am the Secretary of the Priest Personnel Board and the Secretary of the Presbyteral Council to assist Bishop Earl Fernandes.

Do I have hobbies? You'd better believe it. I love to read theology, philosophy, history, and literature. I also enjoy music, watching the Columbus Blue Jackets and Crew, and spending time with family and friends. Finally, I share with you my obsession with classic and modern Volkswagens. I owned a 1968 VW Beetle in the college seminary, which was a great car until I got ordained! You might see me around Hilliard in my Red 1971 Super WV Beetle. And yes, I am a member of the Central Ohio Vintage Volkswagen Club in the area.

In a special way, I thank Fr Bob for his kindness and hard work during this transition. I know I have a lot to learn about St Brendan and I look forward to working with Fr Jacob, Fr Weldit, our deacons, our new School Principal, Mr Mike DeMassimo, and the dedicated parish and school staffs.

What will the next chapter hold for St Brendan the Navigator Parish? I have no clue. I'm not going to pretend to know. And I suppose that is what makes the life of a parish priest an adventure.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Have you ever considered the task before you and thought, No way am I equipped for this? There are certainly times when it seems God is calling us to more than we are prepared for. The prophet Amos never expected to be God's mouthpiece. He was a simple shepherd and a "dresser of sycamores." Yet, Amos listened when God chose him "from following the flock" and instructed him to speak to Israel, even if he may have thought the whole idea quite silly. "Do you really mean me?" we might imagine him saying. We see this theme of God calling those we might least expect to important missions on countless occasions throughout Scripture: Moses had a speech impediment; Rahab was a prostitute; David was a young boy; Ruth was a foreigner; Matthew was a despised tax collector; Paul persecuted the early Christians; and the list goes on. On every occasion, however, trusting in God and listening to his voice was enough for each of these individuals to fulfill the role they were called to, even if they considered themselves the most unlikely candidate for the cause.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In this week's Gospel reading from Mark, Jesus calls for the Twelve and sends them out on mission with specific instructions. The key here is that he gives them *his authority*. They are able to accomplish seemingly impossible things – "preaching repentance, driving out demons, curing the sick" – not through their own power, but through the authority they had in Christ and by being obedient to the precepts he gave them. This is a lesson for all of us – to heed the commands of Christ and rely on his authority, not on our own power. We can live the impossible only through him. Pay close attention to the words from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians when in doubt: "In him *we were also chosen,* destined in accord with the purpose of the One who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so that we might exist for the praise of his glory, we who first hoped in Christ."
