A MESSAGE FROM KARA DAY

As I have been taking down the Christmas decorations around my house, I am shocked at the realization that we are already in the fourth week of Ordinary Time in the liturgical calendar. Often, I have been tempted to engage Ordinary Time as being just that... ordinary, plain, dull, boring. However, if there's one thing I've learned about following Jesus, it's anything but ordinary. When we say "yes" to Jesus, we say "yes" to a life of adventure, abundant joy, and freedom, even in the midst of hardships in our lives.

At the Vine, we seek to witness to high schoolers that being Catholic isn't boring, and that it's actually what provides your life purpose, adventure, and leads to the most fulfilling life. **Here's what some teens at the Vine have to say about their experience of following Jesus:**

"Since I said yes to Him, I've been faced with situations that I never would have gone into before I let Him into my life completely. I was terrified of so many things, but I trusted Him, and those very things I was so afraid of ended up bringing me so much closer to Him. By trusting Him, it's more like He's driving and I'm along for the adventure. With that trust and confidence in Him, I'm not scared of what's coming anymore, I'm excited. Because saying yes to Him, for me, was just the start of the adventure life is!" ~ Elise, sophomore

"Saying yes to Jesus has made my life so much more full. I know my purpose, I know that my worth lies in the Father, and I know that I am made for so much more than I ever could have fathomed before giving my life to Him. I have been filled with an incomparable joy and a peace that truly impacts me every day and makes continuing to say Yes so much easier." ~ Maria, senior

"Jesus has brought me so much joy and peace in my life. He also has set me free from a lot of worries...I believe that every day with Jesus is an adventure" ~ Paige, sophomore

"Saying yes to the Lord is exciting because there is abundant life and freedom found in Him. Life with Christ is not boring as each day He offers something new! I haven't ever found anything that makes me as joyous as living my life totally sold out for Jesus!" ~ Lily, junior

"Recently, I learned that we're not just merely waiting to go to Heaven, but that Heaven has already come to us. We are living eternal life right now! How could life not be a wonderful adventure as St John Paul II said, even in Ordinary Time, when we live knowing that we've won? Ordinary Time seems like extra-Ordinary Time in this lens, and Holy Days of Obligation become Holy Days of Opportunity; opportunity to grow, not just to fulfill an obligation!" ~ Austin, sophomore

"Following Jesus has been a nonstop adventure for me as I grow closer to Him & learn more about His unfathomable goodness. Every day, no matter the liturgical season, our faith should be as living and active as our God!" ~ Addy, junior

THE EUCHARIST AND THE SAINTS: ST JOHN PAUL THE GREAT

Did you ever see Pope John Paul II pray? Each morning, he celebrated Mass in his private chapel with about twenty guests. When this man knelt down to pray after Communion, he would close his eyes and go to a place deep within himself. Once he was there, nothing and no one could distract him from communing with God. What does it mean to commune with God? To share your intimate thoughts and feelings. Pope John Paul II would go to that place deep within himself, and from that place he brought forth the fruit of his life: wisdom, compassion, generosity, understanding, patience, courage, insight. Forgiveness, humility, inspiration, and a love so apparent you could almost touch it.

In those moments after Communion, he allowed nothing to distract him from his prayer. He let nothing draw his attention away from his Divine Visitor in those precious moments after receiving the Blessed Sacrament. The amazing thing is, if you put the same man in a football stadium with a hundred thousand people and a million more distractions, he would still kneel down after Communion, close his eyes and go to that place deep within him where he connected with God. And he lived his life from that place.

He wrote. "The Eucharist is the secret of my day. It gives strength and meaning to all my activities of service to the Church and to the whole world...Let Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament speak to your hearts. It is He who is the true answer of life that you seek. He stays here with us: He is God with us. Seek Him without tiring, welcome Him without reserve, love Him without interruption: today, tomorrow, forever."



Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dt 18:15-20 | 1 Cor 7:32-35 | Mk 1:21-28

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Oh, to not be anxious! What would that be like – to not have to worry about how we'll pay the bills or whether our kids are safe or if our health will fail? While anxiety is a very human emotion, we can take comfort in knowing that our God is more powerful than anything that may worry us. It is also important to note that in today's reading from St Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, what he means by "anxious" is not a modern psychological concept with only a negative connotation. The connotation is more "to be concerned with," or "caring about" something, and can refer to things that are very good – including spouses and families! But when we care for many things, including our relationship with God, it is only natural for us to be anxious at times. But Jesus Christ gives us the assurance that the troubles of this world are temporary, and the peace of God eternal. Paul is encouraging the Corinthians, and us, to understand the importance of an undivided devotion to God, to care for him above all things – no matter if we are married or single – so that our whole life is devoted to holiness.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

I am always thankful when something good that has been anticipated, or predicted, comes to pass: The sunshine and mild weather holds true for that outdoor event I hosted; or the generous gift that a longtime friend mailed arrives unscathed. There is some anxiety in the waiting for, but relief in the fulfillment of, these beneficent promises. And while these are somewhat superficial examples, they do point us in the same direction of hope and gratitude that the divine gifts of God elicit in us. In today's first reading, Moses promises the people that the Lord will raise up for them, from among their own kin, a prophet who will speak God's own words and to whom the people will listen. And the Lord did provide numerous prophets, and kings, and judges, and eventually his only begotten Son, to call his people back to himself, and to save them from the wages of sin and death. The hope and anticipation God's chosen people had was fulfilled in Jesus' life, death and resurrection. We share in that gift of hope and of gratitude for our salvation.

PRAY Today's psalm (Ps 95:1-2, 6-7, 7-9) is a beautiful prayer of thanksgiving and encouragement. It helps us steer our minds from those things which may make us anxious. Spend time in the morning or evening each day of the coming week, praying and reflecting on the words.


