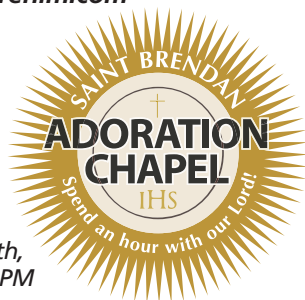

A MESSAGE FROM FR DOOLEY

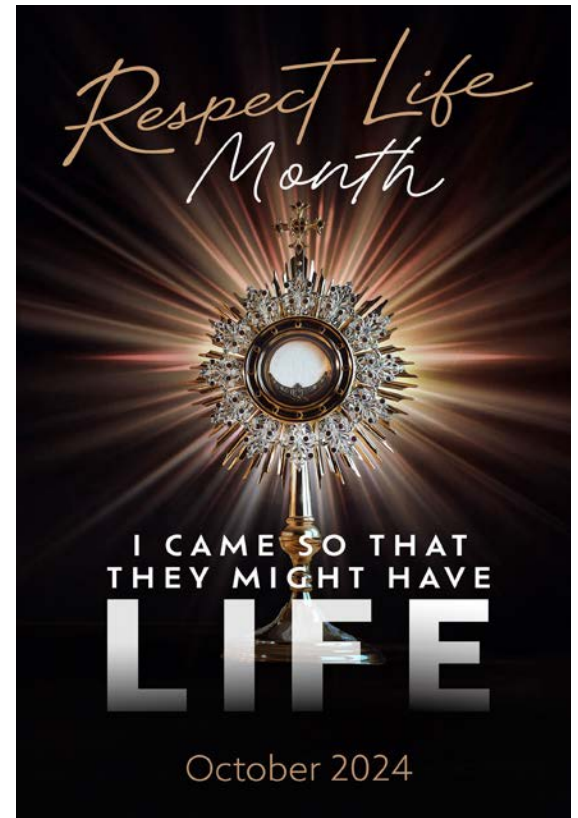

It is hard to believe that the month of October is here. We dedicate the month of October to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and we ask for her intercession for the Church and the world. In our country, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have made the month of October, **Respect Life Month**. The theme this year for Respect Life Month is, *"I came so that they might have life"* (John 10:10). In addition, the Catholic Church is still amid the National Eucharistic Revival. Our defense of the most vulnerable in our society is a top priority for us in this country as we speak for the unborn, mothers and fathers in difficult situations, the poor, the elderly, immigrants and migrants. As Pope St John Paul II wrote, "We are facing an enormous and dramatic clash between good and evil, death and life, the 'culture of death' and the 'culture of life' ...we are all involved and we all share in it, with the inescapable responsibility of choosing to be unconditionally pro-life."

A few years ago, I felt the Lord calling me to enter deeply into healing ministry for those mothers and fathers who suffered from the aftermath of an abortion. This powerful ministry is called Rachel's Vineyard. These weekend retreats allow women and men to grieve and to provide space for them to experience the healing graces of God in their lives. There are really no words to describe the Rachel's Vineyard weekend retreat other than life changing. I will be chaplain for the next Rachel's Vineyard Retreat weekend sometime in February of 2025. As I get closer to that weekend, I will reach out to you for your prayers!

This month, our prayer intention in the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel is for the respect and dignity of all life. I have been blown away by our parish's response to those in need in the form of spiritual, material, and financial support. In January, the Respect Life Committee and the Knights of Columbus will again host a charitable drive for Women's Care Center in Columbus. I have been told that in the past this has been very successful in collecting materials for parents in need.

A question for our parish community – Is there more that we can be doing to accompany mothers, fathers, and families in difficult pregnancies and after birth? As you know, we are not just pro-birth, but we want to provide help to those families who are in desperate need. If you have any ideas or proposals to help these families or any other vulnerable groups such as immigrants, the elderly or those with disabilities, I encourage you to join our Respect Life Committee and to allow God to use your gifts for His greater glory.

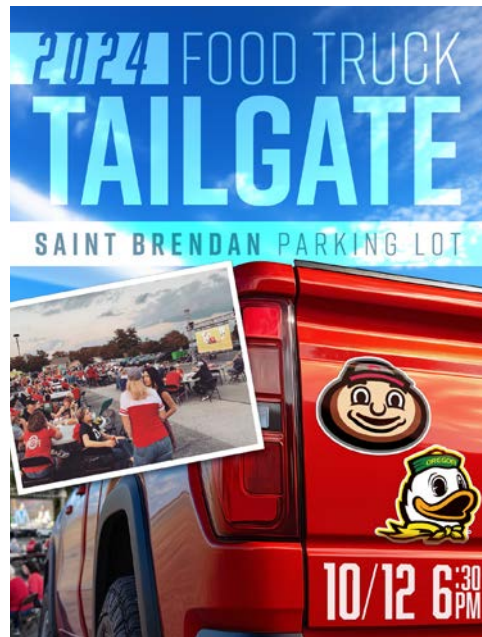

Gn 2:18-24 | Heb 2:9-11 | Mk 10:2-16

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Everything in God's creation is intended to reflect his goodness and proclaim his glory. It's not hard to understand this idea when we behold the majesty of the sea. It can be more difficult, however, to remember this is also present in each of us and in our relationships – including that relationship God designed for man and woman: marriage. Our ability to turn away from God means that we sometimes reject, rather than reflect, him. This is one reason why Jesus responds to the Pharisees' question by revoking Moses' allowance for divorce, a concession God had made to the Israelites in the Old Testament. Jesus' statement might be unsettling because, in our time, divorce has affected nearly *everyone* in one way or another. But his words indicate the strength of the covenant the Lord has made with us: his love is permanent and unbreakable. We learn that the unbreakable bond between spouses reflects, in an imperfect way, God's perfectly faithful love for us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

We find this truth about love in the wisdom of the Church. Love is not a "feeling." It is an action – a virtue – in which we consistently *will the good of another*. After all, this is who and what God is: a continuous outpouring of love. Our triune God is a relational community of love, and Jesus offers us the preeminent example of this: As the Son and out of love for the Father, he *chose* to remain on the cross, regardless of how he *felt*. Such was his love for us that he willed our redemption and sent us the Spirit to help us remain with him. Marriage, designed by God to mirror this triune communal, covenantal love, likewise requires a *decision to love* that is firm and constant, despite how we might *feel*. If we wish to be capable of the fidelity required for marriage, family life, or simply for our relationship with God, we must make the deliberate choice to love – *and we must do it over and over*. With time and with God's grace, the habit of choosing another's good becomes easier, and we experience the joy of a stable and authentic love.
