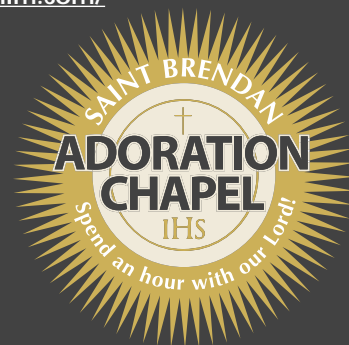

MESSAGE FROM FR BOB

Dear Parish family,

"You have nothing to fear... Today in David's city, a Savior has been born."

These words from St Luke's Gospel reassure us as we listen to the Good News of Christ's birth. The angel's message, spoken down the ages to each one of us, calls us from our anxiety and conflict and draws us into a sense of quiet wonder, as the glory of God's peace breaks into our lives. Perfect love casts out fear, and in Christ, perfect love has taken human flesh, for He is Emmanuel, "God with Us."

We are independently minded men and women. But we were not designed to be so. From an early age, we want our own way, we want the freedom to do what we want to do, when we want to do it. As a result, we often find ourselves caught up in things we regret. God calls to us, just as He did to Adam and Eve in the garden, just as He did some 2,000 years ago when He became man for us. But we choose not to accept that call. We choose not to listen. People run, hide, and create a different world in which God is reduced to an hour on Sundays, or not at all. And so, the world of God's design is shattered because He is no longer the heart and center of all we experience.

An article I read recently talked about a God-shaped hole in our hearts. It's a space for God alone. Until we recognize what it is, we try to fill it up by stuffing earthly things into it – possessions, activities, self-importance. It's like trying to force the wrong piece of a jigsaw puzzle into a space not meant for it. We don't know why we're not satisfied, so we search for novelty in the things we cram into the hole. It doesn't work. Nothing but God will fit the God-shaped hole. And the more we try to fill it, the more the burdens of daily life bear down on us. Sin seems too great or difficult to overcome, so we despair or give up.

We ask ourselves, where can we find hope? Faith in Jesus Christ gives us hope and fills the hole in our lives. Only when we abandon our attempts to create a world of our own making, when we stop trying to stuff our lives with the wrong things, do we discover that Christ's life gives our life meaning. If we really believe in Christ, we will have confidence for the future, no matter how bleak some days may seem.

The prophet Isaiah reminds us that for thousands of years, people tried to create their own meaning and that they walked in darkness. But the darkness did not last. It never does. It never can. Even as the world around us seems to slip into chaos, we are reminded that God the Father breathed forth His Spirit, and sent it to settle on the world, to once again from chaos form and draw together a people chosen to be His own. And this time, God chose to take human flesh so that for all eternity, God's own life might bear a human face. The Spirit was sent to hover this time over a single woman, Mary, our Mother, and through her over each one of us. This was the most that God could give. This was the fullness of gift, the fullness of grace. Never again can humanity completely withdraw from the presence of God. God is Incarnate. God has taken on human flesh, and in Jesus He speaks with a human tongue, touches us with human hands, and loves us with a human heart. Never again need we be trapped in the darkness, without hope, without direction, without focus. We have been promised – God is with us. The Good News has been proclaimed, fear has been cast out, hope is offered to us – the Savior of the world has been born. God's favor rests on us, and there is the promise of peace on earth.

FAMILY FAITH FORMATION

We are on break with no family sessions of middle school small groups until January 9. Our family sessions in January will kick off the Root program for all faith formation families. We are excited to walk together through the first section of the Catechism! You may also want to subscribe to the Catechism in a Year podcast by Ascension. This will increase your understanding of Church teaching and give you more opportunities to share what you are learning with your family.

At this point, all families should have received a link to complete payment for the Faith Formation program. We ask that once you receive the email, you complete payment as soon as possible. SACRAMENT PREPARATION

1ST RECONCILIATION – If you missed the First Reconciliation service on December 10, please reach out to Jacob (jdoran@stbrendans.net) for help scheduling a Confession with one of our priests. All faith formation families should have picked up a *Nourish* box to begin preparation for first Eucharist.

CONFIRMATION – In order for your teen(s) to receive this Sacrament in the Spring, they must have been Baptized as well as received the Sacraments of First Reconciliation/Eucharist. They must also be registered in our St Brendan Faith Formation program or School. If you haven't already, please complete the Sacrament registration form ASAP – once you complete it, you will receive the link to make your payment. The Nativity of the Lord

Is 52:7-10 | Heb 1:1-6 | Jn 1:1-18

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

The day we have been awaiting has arrived: Christ is born! All of our Christmas preparations – wrapping gifts and preparing holiday meals to be shared among family and friends – are meant to glorify and reflect God’s own work for and in us. That is, God’s greatest gift of himself, clothed in mortal flesh, who would one day offer himself as the bread of life: “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.” Jesus came to the world in the form of the most helpless of us all, a newborn infant, so that through him we would be reconciled to the Father, for “to those who did accept him he gave power to become children of God.” We celebrate the Incarnation of the Lord, for Christ is our salvation! It is through Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit that we are adopted into God’s family and receive the fullness of his grace. The fullness of God’s truth is revealed in Jesus Christ. “The Lord has made his salvation known”; “he has spoken to us through the Son.” Let us give thanks and rejoice this day!

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The Good News of Jesus Christ is not meant to be kept to ourselves. Today’s Gospel reading reminds us that John the Baptist testified to the light of Christ before Christ had yet publicly appeared. Sharing the Good News is not optional! Even the earth proclaims the Good News in Isaiah, “announcing salvation, and saying to Zion, ‘Your God is King!’” Indeed, Christ the King – God in human flesh – has arrived. Just as John was sent before the Lord to proclaim his coming, so are we charged: Sent out to the world to go and announce the Gospel of the Lord, “so that all might believe.”

WITNESS How might you go out and proclaim the coming of the Lord? Don’t forget: sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ isn’t limited just to speaking to others. It includes *living* as Christ did – feeding the hungry, caring for the sick and the poor, defending the helpless – because we are Christ’s body in the world.
