EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP

Help make an authentically Catholic education accessible and affordable for all! In late 2021, the Ohio Legislature passed a law creating a tax credit for qualified donations to scholarship granting organizations certified by the Ohio Attorney General. The Diocese of Columbus considers affordable access to a Catholic education a philanthropic priority so the Diocesan Education Corporation (dba Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund) was formed and certified as the first Scholarship Granting Organization in the state.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Donors who make gifts to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund receive a dollar-for-dollar reduction of their Ohio tax liability
- Anyone who would like to make Catholic education accessible for all can make a gift
- No gift is too large or too small (but the Ohio tax credit is limited to \$750 for individuals and \$1,500 if married filing jointly)
- Your gift can be directed to St Brendan OR you can make a gift to the general fund to help students in the diocese

A MESSAGE FROM MADISON STEWART

Happy Advent!

One of my absolute favorite times of the year is finally here! Many different emotions can roll through during this time. We can experience joy and anticipation, waiting for delicious snacks, Christmas Mass, and time with family and friends. We can also experience anxiety from our giant to-do list with everything that needs done. I personally tend to flip flop between soaking in the moment and feeling stressed.

One way to bring Jesus into every aspect of the Advent Season, in the midst of the chaos and movement, is to invite Him there. Where do we spend a lot of our time amidst the holidays? Our cars! So, try making your car a chapel for Advent! But how do we do this?

Here are a few suggestions:

- 1. Make the sign of the cross before entering the car and leaving. Each time the door opens, try making the sign of the cross over yourself. Take time to remind your kids, friends, and family to do the same to welcome Jesus into that small, 5-second gesture.
- **2.** Display a crucifix in your car. Either put a rosary around your mirror or a small sticker or holy card on your dashboard. When we have visible reminders of Jesus, Mary, and the saints, we are reminded of the presence of Christ who is with us always.
- **3.** Listen to worship and Christmas music that honors Jesus. Music is always a great way to pray and let Christ into our lives, singing Christmas carols with the kids on the way to sports events or playing worship music by yourself to give Christ honor and praise.
- **4.** Pray the Rosary or Chaplet on long drives. If you are traveling a long distance, consider praying the Holy Rosary or Chaplet of Divine Mercy together as a family or as a couple. You could even use the Hallow app or Spotify to pray along with.

By creating small habits during this season, the goal is to have them roll over into other areas and seasons in our life. When we give Jesus these small moments amidst the chaos of our normal day to day, He will bless them.

ST BRENDAN'S NEW BAPTISM PREP CLASS

A new Baptism Preparation program is coming to our parish in January called **CLAIM**. It comes from the Faith and Family Life Catholic Ministries and will provide a deeper and richer preparation experience for St Brendan families as they prepare to have their children baptized into the Catholic Church. Baptism Preparation class will still be at 12 PM on the first Sunday of the month; however, there will be two sessions required to complete the program with some materials for the family to work on at home as well.



- Classes are held the 1st Sunday of most months, 12-1 PM and consist of two sessions a month (some materials must be completed in between the 2 sessions)



Second Sunday of Advent

Is 11:1-10 | Rom 15:4-9 | Mt 3:1-12



Harmony. It can seem so elusive in these times when our newsfeeds bombard us with reminders of what's wrong with our world: war, political conflicts, hunger, injustice, violence. We may also experience discord in our homes or within our hearts. Perhaps that is why the beautiful imagery in Isaiah's prophecy, where Isaiah envisions a world transformed by the coming of the Messiah, strikes a chord as we prepare for Christ's coming: We picture the wolf lying beside the lamb, and the calf with the lion. All will be right with the world. As we reflect on the areas in our lives that lack harmony, we are reminded to focus on Jesus and the Father, the source of all good. Through prayer and reflection on our Advent readings, we can "prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths."


