MESSAGE FROM FR STINNETT

WHO REQUIRES OUR ATTENTION THIS WEEK? JESUS!



Holy Week has a wonderful simplicity hidden amidst all the hustle and bustle of liturgical ceremonies. In some sense, it is the busiest time of the Church year. Palms are blessed and distributed; oils are prepared, consecrated, and received; altars are stripped; crosses adored; and Easter lilies blossoming in every nook and cranny where they can fit. It is easy, especially for a priest, to get caught up in the temporal parts of Holy Week. There are many things that require attention.

But there is also just One Who requires our attention this Holy Week: Jesus. The simplicity of Holy Week is that we simply walk beside Jesus in the last week of His life before His Resurrection. We enter the Holy City of Jerusalem with Him on Palm Sunday. We are with Him as He gathers His disciples for the Passover. We are seated around the table when He breaks the bread and gives the cup. We pray with Him in the Garden of Gethsemane, and sadly join the crowd that calls for His crucifixion. On Good Friday, we approach the Cross with a mixture of fear, gratitude, and awe. Then, we enter into the silence of Holy Saturday, when His lifeless Body lay cold in the tomb. Easter Sunday is the Day of Resurrection, the first day of the new order of things. Life returns to earth, and we are among the countless disciples since trying to find and understand the Lord after His Resurrection.

To help us simply walk with Jesus during Holy Week, to give some central meaning to this week behind all the drama, I would like to highlight the Verse Before the Gospel that is used on Palm Sunday and Good Friday. They are identical quotations from St Paul's Letter to the Philippians. St Paul inserted what many scholars believe to be an early liturgical hymn about Jesus' Paschal Mystery in this letter to share with the Church in Philippi.

On Palm Sunday and Good Friday, we will hear these words: *"Christ became obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the Name which is above every name."* There is something utterly simple about the Paschal Mystery that we are celebrating during Holy Week. As we used to say in an older translation of the Mystery of Faith: *"Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again."*

Fr Stefano Gobbi, a twentieth century Italian priest, has a reflection on this hymn from Philippians. He quotes the beginning of the hymn, which speaks about the Incarnation, Jesus' taking on human flesh and truly becoming a man. In it, he opens up the depth of this simplicity that we are invited into this Holy Week: *"God though He was, He did not consider remaining within divinity a treasure to be jealously guarded, but He emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant and, becoming man, became obedient even unto death, the death of the Cross."* Jesus' mission is to welcome all of us, the people He has redeemed into His divinity. This is the goal of the Christian life. St Athanasius so boldly put it: *"God became man so that man might become God!"* During Holy Week, we walk with Jesus as He brings about the new and eternal covenant that allows us to share in God's divine life.

I pray that we each have the opportunity to pause this week, draw close to Jesus in our hearts, and thank Him for making the excruciating sacrifice that allows us to share in the glory of the Risen Christ, which is eternal life, and to be called Christians, after that *"Name which is above every other name."*

We are overcome by bittersweet emotions as we relay the news that Bishop Earl K. Fernandes has appointed Fr Bob Penhallurick as the Pastor of St Catherine of Siena (near Bexley), effective July 9th of this year. Along with the appointment, he will also become Director of a new Diocesan Respect Life Office.



In return, St Brendan has been appointed Fr Sean Dooley as our new Pastor, also effective July 9th. Fr Dooley is a 2006 graduate of Bishop Rosecrans High School in Zanesville. WHAT DO YOU DO AFTER COMMUNION?

We know it is a time of prayer, but we can easily become distracted by what is going on around us. Try praying something already established, either reading it or working to memorize it. This deepens our time with the Lord who has just entered in and gives Him the time and space to work within us. Each week, we will be providing you with one or more prayer suggestions to try.

Stay with me, Lord, for it is necessary to have You present so that I do not forget You. You know how easily I abandon You.

Stay with me Lord, because I am weak, and I need Your strength, so that I may not fall so often.

Stay with me Lord, for You are my life, and without You, I am without fervor.

Stay with me Lord, for You are my light, and without you, I am in darkness.

Stay with me Lord, to show me Your will.

Stay with me Lord, so that I hear Your voice and follow You.

Stay with me Lord, for I desire to love You very much, and always be in Your Company.

Stay with me Lord, if You wish me to be faithful to You.

Stay with me Lord, for as poor as my soul is, I want it to be a place of consolation for You, a nest of Love.

Stay with me, Jesus, for it is getting late, and the day is coming to a close, and life passes, death, judgment, eternity approach. It is necessary to renew my strength, so that I will not stop along the way and for that, I need You. It is getting late and death approaches. 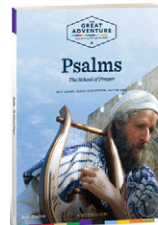

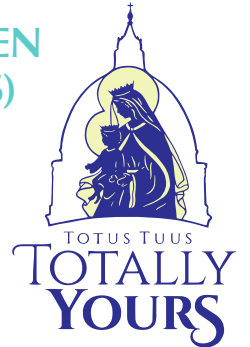

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Is 50:4-7 | Phil 2:6-11 | Mk 14:1-15:47

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"The Lord God has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them." This sentence from our first reading is taken from one of the four "Songs of the Suffering Servant" in Isaiah. The New Testament identifies this Servant as Jesus, and we know that Jesus accepted the suffering that was foretold in the verses that follow this one: "I gave my back to those who beat me ... my face I did not hide from insults and spitting." As aspiring servants of God on this Palm Sunday, the most holy of days when we hear Mark's account of Jesus' passion, how does this sentence speak to us? What does it mean to have a well-trained tongue? To me it is a call to speak to the Lord in prayer as well as to speak the Good News of the Gospel whenever and wherever we can.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

How can we gain the confidence to believe that our tongue is "well-trained"? We know we are all given the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and we must trust in that promise and invoke his presence often. Who knows? A kind word or gesture from us may just "speak" to a weary person who is struggling. Paul writes that in his passion, Jesus "emptied himself" in the hours before his death and "[became] obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross." Paul's next words give us the answer to our question above: "Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend ... and *every tongue confess* [emphasis added] that Jesus Christ is Lord." The fullness of the kingdom will be realized only when Jesus comes again. But in the meantime, we have the Eucharist that Jesus instituted at the Last Supper to sustain us and give us strength for our task to confess Jesus Christ as Lord and spread the kingdom of God one day at a time.

PRAY "Abba, Father, all things are possible to you. Take this cup away from me, but not what I will but what you will." These words from today's passion narrative demonstrate Jesus' complete, obedient surrender of his will to his Father's divine will. As flawed human beings, we will never be able to perfectly emulate our Savior's actions, but what better way to begin Holy Week than to try? Through prayer, strive to surrender yourself to God this week by trusting him completely, and striving to do his will with humility and Christ-like obedience.
