



A MESSAGE FROM JENNIFER RICE

Today, we celebrate **Divine Mercy Sunday**, still a newer addition to our liturgical calendar, that focuses on St Faustina's encounter with Jesus and the love and mercy in His message for all souls. The novena that we pray leading up to this day focuses on a different group of souls each day, a reminder that we all need God's great mercy in our lives.



Do we trust that we will receive it? Whether due to our current culture or our own wounds, trust can be elusive. We have been disappointed, betrayed. People end up being not who they appeared to be. We place our trust in temporary fixes for our brokenness: the latest self-help book, YouTube video or someone's advice, or just grasp our need to control a little tighter. I can trust myself. If it gets messed up then it's all on me. And it is exhausting.

In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus tells us, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." Jesus asks us to trust Him with our needs, to learn a different, better way to live – in a surrender and trust of His plan for us. His healing, His promises are better than anything we can imagine for ourselves. We know this, and we notice this if we look back in our history of where Jesus has already done this for us, but often in the moment of trial we forget.

How, practically, do we learn to trust Him? This month, we are focusing on trusting Him first in prayer. We must first remove the obstacles in our lives that keep us from hearing His voice. With so many other voices influencing us, keeping His above all else is key. That happens in quiet prayer, putting aside time for Him in our day to ask Him to guide us, and to be open to the holy interruptions of our own plans.

Another wonderful tool is the **Litany of Trust**, written by Sister Faustina Maria Pia of the Sisters of Life. Praying this litany and perhaps centering on a few of the phrases to repeat in prayer through the day, can make it first in your mind as you encounter challenges that demand trust. For example: **From anxiety about the future, deliver me Jesus. Or: That You give me all the strength I need for what is asked, Jesus I trust in You.** Find a verse that God is speaking especially to you, write it down and pray it for a week. Then, choose another to pray.

Please also join us on April 26 at 10 AM or 7 PM as we further explore trust in prayer with intentions and surrender. May we learn to trust the Lord who has rescued us with His mercy and provides all that we need in His time and in His way.







FAMILY FAITH FORMATION

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

FIRST RECONCILIATION – If your child missed the group celebration of this Sacrament held on December 3, please bring them to one of the times listed below that St Brendan offers for Confession. Once your child receives the Sacrament, let us know so that it can be recorded and a certificate can be prepared for you to pick up.

- Wednesdays from 6-7 PM (during Adoration time)
- Saturdays from 9 AM until all are heard

FIRST COMMUNION – Everyone should be registered for this Sacrament and have supplied a copy of all Baptism certificates of students not Baptized at St Brendan. The First Eucharist Retreat and practice are on Friday, April 28 from 4:30-8:30 PM or Saturday, April 29 from 10 AM–2 PM. We encourage both parents to attend but ask that at least ONE parent attends with their child. Make sure to RSVP for one of the sessions.

CONFIRMATION – Confirmation is on Friday, April 21 at 4 PM or 7 PM. Please arrive 30 minutes prior to Mass. Candidates and sponsors will gather in the Davidson Road Meeting Rooms when they arrive and then sit with their sponsor in reserved pews at the front of the church before Mass begins. Due to the Bishop's instructions for Mass, Confirmation candidates will be seated with their sponsors in the front of the Church for the Confirmation Mass. All other seating will be general seating and not reserved. No pictures are allowed during Mass to preserve the sanctity of the Sacraments. You are welcome to take pictures in and around the church after Mass has ended. Please email sacraments@stbrendans.net with any questions.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

"I'll believe it when I see it." We've all said this at some point, usually in response to hearing about someone unreliable doing something out of character. St. Thomas had the same reaction in today's Gospel when he wasn't there when the other disciples saw Christ for the first time since he rose from his tomb - "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." Although Jesus helped Thomas with his unbelief, he blesses those who have not seen, but believe. Have any of us seen the nail marks in Christ's hands and feet, or the wound in his side? Do we see Christ's body and blood on the altar, or do we see only the gifts of bread and wine? Christ comes to us in ways we can understand initially - parables, bread and wine, the face of people we meet throughout our daily lives - but our faith in what we have not seen, in the great mystery of our salvation, is what makes us Christian.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's first reading, we hear reports of the lives of the first disciples soon after Pentecost: communal living, breaking bread together, prayer, selling of their property and possessions and redistributing among themselves according to individual needs. To our ears today, this idyllic community living seems almost incredible. Yet these first disciples were infused with the Holy Spirit, who enabled them to proclaim the Gospel and think of others before themselves. As Christ's disciples today, how are we behaving toward one another? If we truly are among those who have not seen and yet believe, let's act in full confidence. As we heard in the second reading, our faith is "more precious than gold that is perishable even though tested by fire." We certainly aren't perfect, and our faith at times can be sorely tested, and yet this is our call: to share this faith by doing good works in Christ's name to make disciples and build the kingdom of God.

INVITATION People often see Christ through the words and actions of others. This week, actively seek out opportunities to be the hands of Christ. What opportunities does your community have to practice corporal works of mercy?




