GROWING CATHOLICISM ACROSS CENTRAL OHIO

A MESSAGE FROM BEN ROMAKER

As was communicated in the recent campaign to support seminarian formation, "A Good and Growing Need," we had 16 young men enter the seminary last year. At least 10 additional seminarians in our diocese are expected to begin their path to the priesthood this year. After zero ordinations in 2022, this incredible, new momentum should be refreshing to Columbus Catholics who have been concerned about our culture and the trajectory of our faith institutions. As someone who is often tasked with photographing our ministries, sacraments, and initiations, the enthusiasm and sheer numbers at these events are often inspiring.



For Catholic families at St Brendan engaged enough to be reading this very bulletin, it is absolutely vital that we lean into this momentum. In a speech given by Bishop Earl K. Fernandes at St Brendan in February, the bishop referred to our parish as a shining example of a faith community "that goes forth, boldly proclaiming the Gospel." We've been bestowed with the responsibility to share our love, spread our zeal, and care for "the life and future of our whole diocese."

Each year, **The Appeal** serves as the best way to foster Catholic initiatives throughout Central Ohio. Each gift is redistributed to support things like seminarian education, marriage preparation and enrichment programs, tuition assistance for Catholic schools, hospital and prison ministries, and growing faith communities like Fr Weldit's Eritrean congregation here in Columbus. Funds are also allocated to agencies affiliated with Catholic Social Services, meaning your contribution will also provide aid to impoverished families, essential services for seniors, and behavioral healthcare for children.

This year's Appeal theme, **Respond to His Love**, is a call-and-response. Jesus said, "This is my command: Love one another as I have loved you." His love for us cannot go unrequited. We are additionally called upon by Bishop Fernandes and Fr Bob to make a sacrificial gift of love in support of the Catholic ministries that surround us. An offering towards this year's parish goal of **\$295,406** is every bit as fundamental as your weekly contribution to offertory at St Brendan. I ask you to join me in pledging a gift, knowing that no amount is too large or too small. 100% participation, even gifts of \$10 or \$20 from new donors, will be the key to our success.

For the faithful in Columbus, many of our perennial prayers surrounding faith and culture are receiving tangible and literal answers. New Catholics are receiving their sacraments in droves and dozens of young men are discerning the priesthood. Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11 | Eph 1:17-23 | Mk 16:15-20

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It's easy for me to get impatient with the Lord - to wonder why he makes me wait for an answer to a prayer or, worse, why his answer may be no. However, when I look back at the lessons of the Bible, it becomes clear that God works on his timetable, not mine. That same message comes through in today's first reading. The apostles ask Jesus whether he will be restoring the kingdom to Israel, and he is clear in his answer: "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority." And then, after saying this, he ascends to the Father. Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus has left his disciples again. But instead of leaving them to weep and mourn - as happened after his death - this time, our Lord left them with a mission. They were to "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." They did, faithfully, and they traveled far and wide. Armed with the gift of the Holy Spirit which they received at Pentecost, they baptized countless people as they shared the Good News about Jesus and his gift of salvation.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

After Jesus gives the disciples the command to go out and preach the Gospel, he says that "whoever believes and is baptized will be saved." He offers salvation for those who believe in him. And he says that the disciples, and us, will be his witnesses in the world. Sacred tradition tells us that Andrew and Philip preached in Asia Minor while Bartholomew and Thomas spent time in India. Others are said to have gone to Palestine, Persia, and Ethiopia. All died a martyr's death - except John who had been entrusted with the care of our Blessed Mother. We are his witnesses today, and we are also commissioned to go into the world and proclaim the Gospel. Today, as we celebrate his ascension into heaven, let us allow ourselves a moment to gaze upward and behold Jesus' power and glory. Let the Ascension renew our commitment to do the work he has asked us to do, and remind us of his presence here with us in all that we do.
