



MESSAGE FROM FR WELDIT

PENTECOST AND THE HOLY SPIRIT!

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church. The name of the day “Pentecost” is a Greek word meaning 50th. There is a parallel Jewish holiday, Shavu’ot, which falls 50 days after Passover.

Shavu’ot is sometimes called the Festival of Weeks, referring to the seven weeks since Passover. Originally a harvest feast, Shavu’ot now commemorates the sealing of the Old Covenant, when the Lord revealed the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai. Every year, the Jewish people renew their acceptance of the gift of the Torah on this feast.

In the Christian tradition, Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered in the Upper Room. Jesus had promised His apostles that He would send them the Comforter, the Holy Spirit, who would conquer the world, and guide them into all truth (John 16:7-13). A “strong, driving” wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other. It was such a strange phenomenon that some people thought the Christians were just drunk — but Peter pointed out that this phenomenon was caused by the Holy Spirit. (Act 2:13) The disciples, witnesses of the glory of the Risen Christ, were filled with the strength of the Holy Spirit and their minds and hearts were opened to a new light.

They had followed Christ and accepted His teachings with faith, but they were not always able to fathom the full meaning of His words. The Spirit of Truth, who was to teach them all things, had not yet come. They knew that Jesus alone could give them words of eternal life, and they were ready to follow Him and give their lives to Him. But they were weak, and in the time of trial, they fled and had left Him alone. On Pentecost, all that is a thing of the past. The Holy Spirit, who is the Spirit of strength, made them firm, strong, and daring. When they received the Holy Spirit, wonderful things began to happen, so their whole lives were changed, renewed, and they were ready to overcome any opposition for their faith. They were clothed with the Spirit and became resolute in their faith. Realizing that there was a power within them, they set out for the victory of the Gospel to change the world.

The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the Great Commission — to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be “clothed with power” before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel.

Similarly, if we have been baptized as infants and confirmed as teens, the Holy Spirit is also with us as well. The Holy Spirit unites our whole lives in love and sanctifies us. Along with sanctifying grace, at Baptism we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of God), and are infused with the theological virtues of faith, hope, and love. In addition, we also receive gifts of healing, works of power, prophecy, and discernment of spirits. God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us. A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. To one person the Spirit gives the ability to give wise advice; to another the same Spirit gives a message of special knowledge. (1 Corinthians 12:6-8) These gifts provided by God supernaturally, help us in the process of our “perfection.” They enable us to transcend the limitations of human reason and human nature and participate in the very life of God, as Christ had promised (John 14:23).

Is there a language that everybody can understand? Yes, there is such a gift, such a language. It is the language of Love! This is a language we can all understand. Love is the language of the Spirit. Love is the only force that can make things one without destroying them and is capable of creating unity. Pope Francis, in his homily of the Pentecost, invites each of us to keep listening to the Holy Spirit who teaches us where to begin, shows us what paths to take, rekindles God’s love in our hearts and directs us on our journey. When the living, Risen Jesus breathes out His Holy Spirit upon us, He sets us on fire with His love!




Pentecost Sunday

Acts 2:1-11 | 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 or Gal 5:16-25 | Jn 20:19-23 or Jn 15:26-27; 16:12-15

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Pentecost Sunday is here! If ever there was a day in the Church calendar to celebrate the transformational power of Christianity, this is it. We know from the first reading how the disciples go from being huddled and afraid in a locked room to stepping out boldly in the streets, loudly proclaiming the Good News of Jesus. What changed them so suddenly? It was the coming of the Holy Spirit, the third divine person of the Trinity, into their hearts and lives. Jesus calls the Spirit an Advocate, “the Spirit of truth,” who will remain with the apostles after he has left. That same Spirit is promised to us, continuing the Easter joy. It is only through the power and grace of the Holy Spirit that we have the knowledge, ability, and courage to proclaim Jesus as our Lord. Only in this way can we belong to Jesus and be in relationship with the Father. The very same God who created all things is here to help us become the sons and daughters he always envisioned us to be.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

“Peace be with you,” Jesus says, twice, to his disciples today. He approaches them with gentleness and a calming demeanor. He is aware of their fear and their anxiety, and that they would be confused and unsure upon seeing him in his resurrected body. Jesus offers us the same words: “peace be with you.” For he knows we, too, can be afraid and unsure about what living out his words will mean to our lives. But we need not be worried! The Holy Spirit, that helper and advocate who came to the first disciples, is here to help us fill our hearts with love and joy and speak our beliefs without fear. When we open our hearts to God’s love, Jesus tells us, the Holy Spirit “will guide [us] to all truth.” In other words, he will be there to help us. As Paul states in the reading from Corinthians, we all have different gifts of the Spirit, and the important thing is that we use those gifts and talents to model ourselves after Jesus.
