SUMMER HAPPENINGS...

Summer! I can hear Olaf from "Frozen" singing that song in my head as I count down the days until the end of school (finished by the time you see this!). Summer is a time for a slower pace and time together. While we slow down a bit here at St Brendan, we are still building the Kingdom with opportunities for faith, service and fellowship.

This weekend, we **celebrate those graduating from high school** with a special blessing at 5:30 Sunday Mass and a reception afterward. We want to remain connected to and pray for our parishioners as they go forward, so we ask them to fill out a card with their contact info and where their next adventure will take them. Congratulations to all!

Next weekend, we celebrate the **feast of Corpus Christi** and begin the Parish Eucharistic Year with a procession after the 10:45 AM Mass and Adoration until 5 PM. This focus on the Eucharist, our source and summit, will be prominent in our offerings this coming year as we continue prioritizing prayer. For example, we will have **Anchored in Adoration** on the second Wednesdays through the summer instead of taking a break and our Adoration hours will not decrease. We are witnessing great fruit from the expansion of the hours since the fall and want to keep this momentum. We are currently planning **24-hour Adoration** on the first Friday of each month, starting in July.

Speaking of Adoration and our Eucharistic center, please consider making a regular commitment to spend an hour in Adoration this summer. What a beautiful way to turn our own eyes to the Eucharist and deepen its meaning in our lives this year. We have several hours where there are no regular commitments and all hours do need two adorers. Unsure about staying a whole hour or what to do? We recognize that can be intimidating! Each adorer started off the same way (including me!) and we have witnessed people settle in and then eventually commit to an hour. Try stopping by for just 15 minutes this summer. Stay tuned for more ways to get comfortable in Adoration.

We invite you also to check out our Year of Prayer page for ideas for your faith this summer. A **Summer Reading List** will be posted with suggestions for spiritual reading. Have a suggestion? Send me an email to jrice@stbrendans.net. We also have received 200 copies of **Matthew Kelly's Holy Moments** (thank you!), a short, practical guide to filling any voids with meaningful moments. Grab yours and get started on your summer reading!

Finally, come celebrate all we are at St B at our **parish picnic** on June 25 at noon in the MPR. It is a time to eat, play, and experience the fellowship of this vibrant community. New this year is a **ministry fair** to browse and connect with different opportunities in the parish. We also recognize that our brothers and sisters are often in greater need in the summer with donations not as prominent, so St Vincent de Paul is collecting individually packaged snacks for **St Lawrence Haven** at the picnic. Thank you for helping us help others!

May God richly bless and renew you this summer through the gift of the Eucharist!

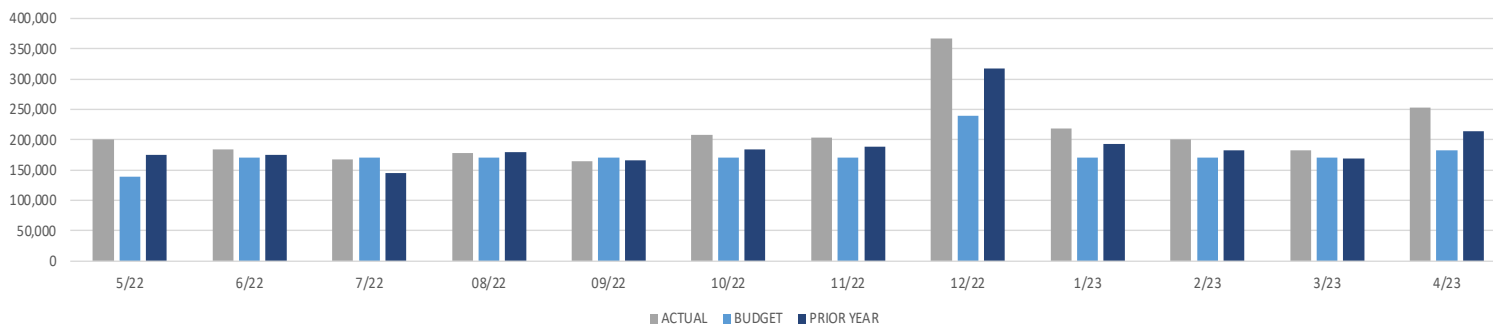

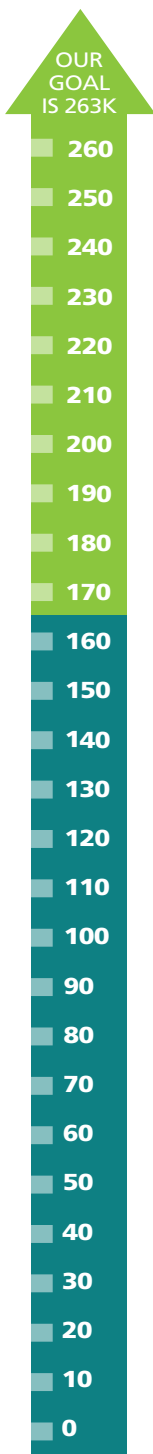

FAMILY FAITH FORMATION & SACRAMENT PREPARATION

For the 2023-24 year, Family Faith Formation at St Brendan will begin to offer three different pathways for families. Each family will be involved in one of the following:

SEEK & ROOT - If you are new to family faith formation, you will join the Seek & Root pathway. These families meet on Monday night at church 10 times throughout the year - twice a month in September and October, and once a month November-April.

SACRAMENT PREPARATION - Families returning to family faith formation and preparing one (or more!) of their children for a sacrament this year will meet on a Monday night five times throughout the year, in addition to sacramental celebrations. These family sessions run from October-March.

CONTINUED GROWTH - Families returning to family faith formation who are not preparing any children for a sacrament are part of the continued growth pathway, which meets on a Sunday morning or evening, OR Monday night 8 times from September-April.

Each of these pathways needs volunteers, too! We need catechists, aides, middle school small group leaders, and parent small group leaders. Please reach out if you have a heart for families - whether it be parents, children, or both!

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Last Sunday the Church celebrated the Solemnity of Pentecost: the birthday of the Church and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit into the world. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, giving adoration and glory to the three divine persons in our one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – three in unity, or Triune. In the Gospel we heard, John tells us: “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” If you're going to write one Bible verse on a piece of cardboard and hold it up at a football game, this is it! John 3:16 encapsulates a Christian belief: We are loved by the Father beyond measure, and that love is incarnated – takes human flesh – in the divine person of his Son. But there is something deeper within this verse that comes to light much later in the Gospel: Jesus revealed that when he, the Son, returned to the Father, he would not leave us alone. (Jn 14: 26-28) Instead, the Holy Spirit came to be with us and remain with us. This is our God whom we celebrate and give thanks to: one in being, three in person. His love is unceasing and his Spirit dwells within and among us to guide us, advocate for us, and draw us ever closer to himself in that love.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

When it comes to evangelization, you could write a Bible verse on a piece of cardboard, hold it up in a crowded place and hope it piques someone's interest. But we can take a cue from St. Paul in the second reading as well. He encourages us to mend our ways, encourage one another and “greet one another with a holy kiss.” And then he offers a prayer for the Corinthians: “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.” Imagine what the world would be like if we all lived like that – if we worked to mend our mistakes, encouraged each other, and earnestly prayed for the grace, love, and fellowship of God to be upon every person. That would be a true witness to God's presence in the world.

PRAY This week, pray a Holy Trinity novena. The word “novena” comes from the Latin word for “nine,” and they typically include nine days of prayer, asking God for a specific intention, and beginning or ending on a feast or solemnity. Trust in the Triune God who loves you and offer him your heart. You may find the comfort or wisdom you seek.

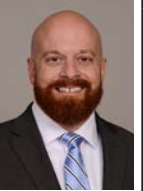

