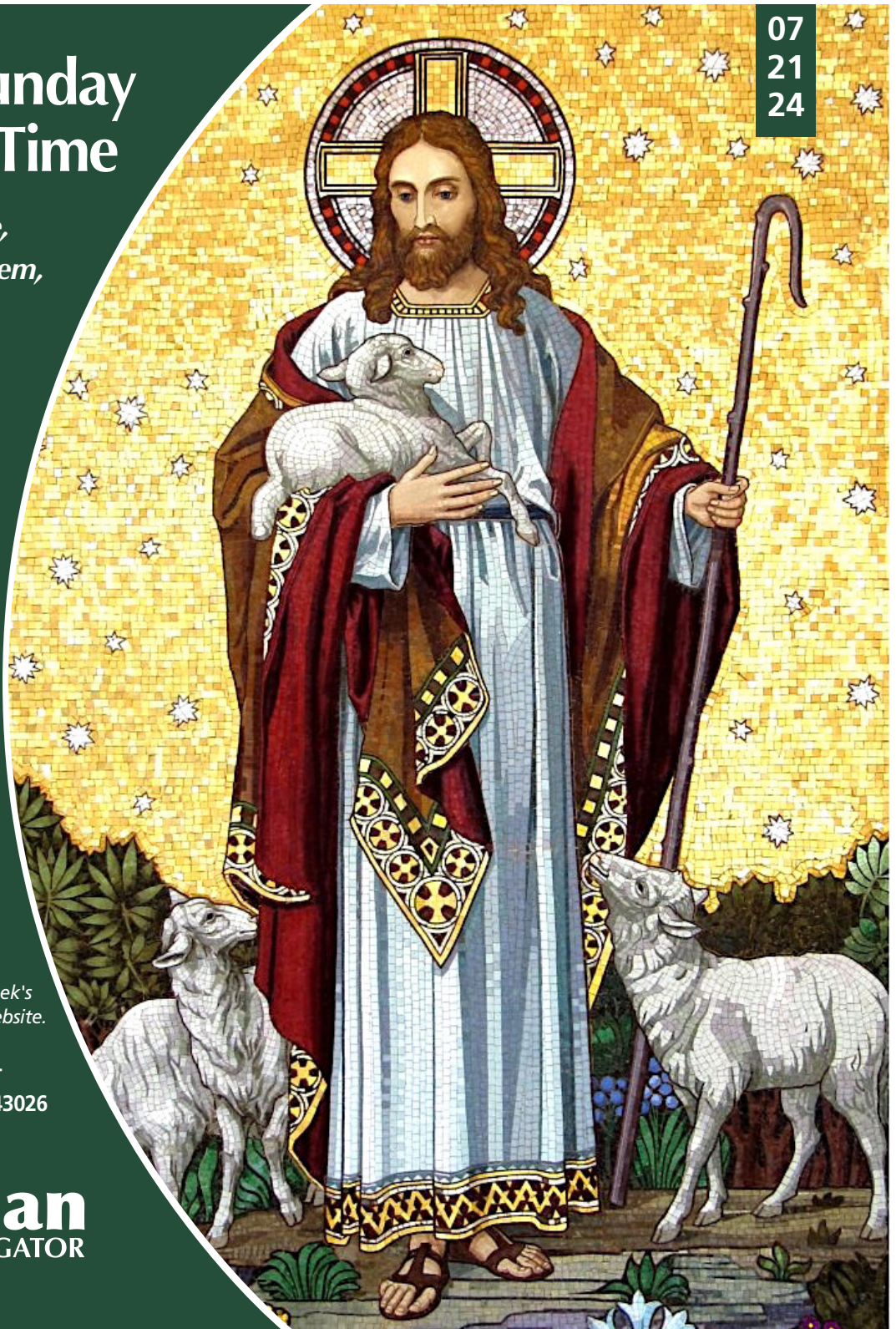

A MESSAGE FROM MAGGIE AGRA

ST MANUEL GONZALEZ GARCIA: A PRIEST OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL



"I ask to be buried next to a Tabernacle, so that my bones, after death, as my tongue and my pen in life, are saying to those who pass: there is Jesus! There He is! Do not let Him be abandoned!"

St Manuel Gonzalez Garcia is one of the patrons of the National Eucharistic Congress, fittingly so. He had a deep and profound love

for Jesus in the Eucharist. As I was preparing to travel to the National Eucharistic Congress, in Indianapolis, I came across this story of St Manuel which deeply struck me.

Manuel was ordained a priest in 1901, in Seville, Spain. For his first assignment, he was sent to an abandoned parish, whose parishioners rarely attended Mass. The altar cloths of the church were torn and burnt and the Tabernacle itself was covered in cobwebs. In this moment, he felt a deep helplessness. He even considered leaving and asking for a different assignment. However, he knelt and began to pray. St Manuel writes of the prayer, saying:

"My faith was looking at Jesus through the door of that tabernacle, so silent, so patient, so good, gazing right back at me....His gaze was telling me much and asking for more.

It was a gaze in which all the sadness of the Gospels was reflected; the sadness of "no room in the Inn"; the sadness of those words, "Do you also want to leave Me?"; the sadness of poor Lazarus begging for crumbs from the rich man's table; the sadness of the betrayal of Judas, the denial of Peter, of the soldier's slap, of the spittle in the Praetorium, and the abandonment of all. All of this sadness was there in that tabernacle, oppressing and crushing the sweet Heart of Jesus and drawing bitter tears from his eyes."

At that moment, St Manuel felt how much we ignore the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. He profoundly experienced the suffering of Christ as all abandoned Him. As many as 70% of Catholics today believe that the Eucharist is not truly the Body and Blood of Christ. Through this experience, St. Manuel realized the most well-known secret to revival and conversion of souls – namely, that it begins with our own heart. We must give our entire selves to the Eucharist and cultivate a deep reverence for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

And that is exactly what the National Eucharistic Congress was aiming to do this past week. This 10th Eucharistic Congress (the last one having happened 83 years ago) describes itself as "an invitation to experience profound personal revival so we can be sent out to share Christ's love with a world that so desperately needs it." Whether we were able to physically be there or not, or whether we caught the livestream or not, we too can experience profound revival through the Eucharist. Through a holy hour in Adoration, through going to Mass with our families, or even just sitting in front of the Tabernacle, we can encounter Jesus. And He desires to see, know, and love us. Jesus is waiting for you. The invitation is simply this; go visit Him.

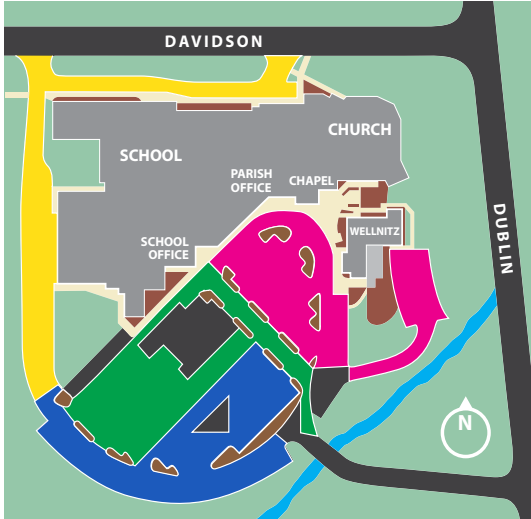

BEWARE OF SOCIAL MEDIA SCAMS!

An increasing number of social media accounts posing as Bishop Earl Fernandes are targeting individuals online and requesting money. The fake social media accounts appear to be targeting older adults, retirees or those with perceived less technology experience. Sometimes, accounts will send messages directly to an individual or they may send online friend requests. They will hook people in by sending a general, positive message, and then, after that, say they need money now, offer a link to buy gift cards, or ask for a money wire transfer.

Individuals who encounter such scams are encouraged to report them. Facebook offers a reporting function that enables a social media user to report another user's account profile for being fake, spam, presenting false information or inciting harm to other people. Bishop Fernandes' official online accounts are **Facebook.com/Bishop.Earl.Fernandes** and **Instagram.com/BishopEarlKFernandes** and his official accounts on the "Columbus Catholic" are **Facebook.com/cbuscatholic** and **Instagram.com/columbuscatholics**, so you can verify them. The Diocese of Columbus social media accounts will only post messages from the bishop's official accounts on their pages.

To detect fraud, look for incorrect spelling and grammar and if a person's name on a social media account is spelled correctly. Fraudulent accounts typically pressure somebody to take action, whether it's giving personal information, asking for money or meeting in person. Official accounts will not request thousands of dollars, a wire transfer, or ask anyone to meet publicly in a short amount of time.

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jer 23:1-6 | Eph 2:13-18 | Mk 6:30-34

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

What words do we associate with being misled? Deceived, fooled, cheated? While these actions make great plot points in novels and movies, in real life they are offenses against justice, charity, and truth. In both the first reading and the Gospel today, we hear that God's people are being misled ("Woe to the shepherds who mislead and scatter the flock of my pasture") and/or left to their own devices ("for they were like sheep without a shepherd"). In the time of Jeremiah the kings of Judah, who were shepherding in God's name, were not tending their flock: They had "scattered [his] sheep and driven them away." Jeremiah prophesies that the Lord will gather the remnant of his flock and bring them back to their meadow; in short, the Lord offers hope. He would raise up from the house of David a true shepherd to guide and guard his people. The incarnation of Jesus is the manifestation of that hope, and in him we have a guiding light to lead us along the correct path. He will never deceive, fool, or cheat. In this world filled with unrest and division, he offers something that no mortal man or woman can: He is the one who saves and redeems. He is the one true shepherd.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

When life is packed with activities and stress, today's readings remind us what we need to do - let go of our worries and focus on Jesus. Just as, in the first reading, God's people are scattered because of poor shepherding, all of us can lose sight from time to time of what should be first and foremost in our lives: our relationship with Jesus. The key to living a good life is to listen to Jesus' words and disregard all the other noise out there. St. Paul writes that Christ is our peace, reconciling us to God and giving us access in one Spirit to the Father, through himself. In addition to Jesus bringing us the peace we need, he also guides us to the Truth. As Christians, we choose Truth over chaos and deception. It's easy to be inadvertently misled in this busy world; losing one's way is rarely intentional. But we can all struggle at times with keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus and his loving, guiding hand. If we want true peace in our lives, choose Jesus; choose his compassion and love; and be open to his desire to "teach [us] many things."

PRAY This week find your true rest and peace by meeting Jesus at daily Mass or Eucharistic adoration. Even better, why not share the peace of Christ with someone who you know might be struggling, and invite them to come to Mass or adoration with you? The crowds of people who came to see Jesus learned about him from others; let us do the same and share the joy we find in Jesus with others.

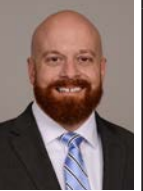
