

A MESSAGE FROM FR STINNETT

Hello St Brendan the Navigator!

I wanted to take this opportunity to introduce myself so you can know a little about your new parochial vicar. First of all, don't worry about how to pronounce my last name. However it comes out, I will respond to it. I always tell people that my family pronounces it one way, most of the world pronounces it another, and I stopped

caring 15 years ago. Also, if you find just calling me "Father Jacob" is easier, that's great too.

I am a Columbus native, growing up in Clintonville. I attended Immaculate Conception School and St Charles. I began to hear my calling to the priesthood when I was in the eighth grade. There were lots of events that came together that year. The most significant was the death of a classmate from a six-year battle with cancer. His death was the first time I really had to grapple with the truths that our Catholic faith teaches about life, death, consolation, and resurrection. Being raised in a Catholic home and receiving a good Catholic education gave me a lot of head knowledge and a basic Catholic outlook on the world. But this was the first time I had to rise to the occasion and claim my faith for myself. People have been saying this is true and they believe it, but do I?

Thanks to the help and great witness of our pastor and resident seminarian, I took the first steps then of making this faith that had been passed down to me my own. I became interested in the Church like never before, because there was something of me invested in it. I also received the Sacrament of Confirmation that year from Bishop Campbell. The Holy Spirit was definitely at work, leading me to hear the quiet voice of God prompting me to respond. The challenge of faith, the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and the witness of good priests all came together to put the question in my mind: "Is this something I could do too?"

My vocational path was rather common a few generations ago, but more unusual today. I entered seminary right after high school and went all the way through in seven years. Many people take more time before they commit to seminary or are ready to give themselves to the Lord. Whatever path we take is the path the Lord wants us to be on. Each of us has a unique journey with the Lord, and I am excited to be a part of your journey with Him. No path is easy or straightforward, as much as mine sounds like it might be. We are all works in progress, but the important thing is that we come to know the One Who is working on us, the One Who is seeking to claim and change our hearts, and His Name is Jesus!

SPECIAL ELECTION, AUGUST 8

A special election will take place in Ohio on August 8 to vote on Issue 1, which asks voters if Ohio should "Require that any proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Ohio receive the approval of at least 60 percent of eligible voters voting on the proposed amendment." As our bishops remind us, "In the Catholic Tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation" (Faithful Citizenship, No. 13.) Important dates:

- NOW-AUGUST 6: Absentee/early in-person voting
- TUESDAY, AUGUST 8: ELECTION DAY

The bishops of Ohio do not have a position on Issue 1, as it does not promote any direct moral content. The proposed November ballot initiative however, which would enshrine abortion, is opposed by Ohio bishops. Read more below.

ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT...

The dignity of life is being threatened in Ohio by a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution that claims to recognize reproductive freedoms, but removes current safeguards for women. Three primary concerns about the amendment are: it puts women at risk, endangers preborn children and enables those who pressure women into abortion. As Catholics, we find the proposed amendment unjust and contrary to our belief in the sacredness of all life. 

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Wis 12:13, 16-19 | Rom 8:26-27 | Mt 13:24-43

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

The parables were always my favorite Gospel readings when I was growing up. One we just heard, regarding the wheat and the weeds, was particularly comforting to me as a child. It was simple to understand, I thought: Those of us in God's Church were obviously the wheat and, of course, destined for salvation. We just needed to endure living among "the weeds" while we are in this world. As an adult, however, I realize that Jesus' message is much more challenging - much more convicting regarding my own failures and sins: I could be a weed! And while I certainly don't like that thought, I also don't like considering that anyone would be thrown into the "fiery furnace." After all, we are supposed to love one another and desire that they become part of the body of Christ and have eternal life. The reality of this world, however, is that temptation and sin surround us. Fortunately, Jesus gives us himself as the Bread of Life in the Eucharist, and we have the gift of mercy in the sacrament of reconciliation. These sacraments, as well as prayer, give us the "nutrients" we need to ensure that we remain the wheat God has sown in his field, and that we can help others be that too.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

While the sacraments can fortify our faith, what about our neighbors, friends or family who are not Catholic or who have fallen away from the Church? This is where evangelization comes in – inviting someone to join you at Mass or suggesting a religious book they might enjoy reading. If you don't think such a simple act could make much difference in the life of another, take heart in the parables contained in the long form of today's Gospel. In those, Jesus reminds us that it doesn't take much to spread the Good News of the kingdom of heaven. The smallest of seeds can turn into the largest of plants and a small amount of yeast can leaven much flour. And if we have moments where we lack courage or feel in need of assistance, St. Paul reminds us that "the Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness." Never underestimate the power of the Advocate: he can help us pray, can intercede for us, and provide what we need to be good seed in the world.

PRAY Let us pray this week for the strength to live out our baptismal promise to reject evil, and to gain courage so as to be a witness to God, and to work toward building his kingdom on earth wherever and whenever we can.




