THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS IS OVER...NOW WHAT?

In the last year, we have journeyed as a parish to revive our relationship with Jesus as we have grown to know and love Him more through the Eucharist. Deepening our participation at Mass, increasing our time in Adoration, and learning more about who Jesus is through prayer, studies and programs, have filled this year at St. Brendan.

Bishop Andrew Cozzens, Chairman of the National Eucharistic Revival, tells us that the Revival began with an invitation to parishes in preparation for the mission phase, the most important phase of all. The vision is that "through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, the People of God in our country would be formed, healed, converted, united, and sent out to a world that is hurting and hungry." Today begins our next year of Eucharistic Revival: The Year of Mission.

In the coming year, there are four new pillars on which to focus: Eucharistic encounter, identity, life, and mission. Our goal is to provide holy opportunities for encounter, form minds and hearts for a Eucharistic identity, offer guidance and spiritual nourishment for living a Eucharistic life, and ready people for mission within our parish and beyond our walls.

What does this look like practically for us?

While our discernment is fluid with the nudging and holy interruptions by the Holy Spirit, we have three areas in our vision. The first is prayer, obviously bringing more before Jesus in the Mass and Adoration, but also really increasing our culture of intercessory prayer. We have introduced pieces with our Anchored prayer teams and prayer list/wall, but we want to be more intentional: praying for parish events, people, and causes, teaching people how to pray for their families and with their families and friends, and making prayer the starting point for every day, challenge and decision.

The second vision is spiritual companionship.

One important initiative from the Revival is "Walk with One." Who is someone in your life who is on the fringes, lukewarm, away from the Church or has never been? Can you walk spiritually with one person this year to gently lead them home? We will also offer time to heal, to ask questions, to be spiritually counseled in our walks, equipping our parishioners to become companions by being open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Inviting Catholics Home has been doing this in the background for many years and we need to bring this beautiful ministry forward.

Finally, going out on mission is, in gratitude for Christ's love, taking His love out into the world.



GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

When have you grumbled against God instead of consenting, trusting, and believing he would see you through to a brighter future? In this first reading from Exodus, the whole Israelite community laments over their wanderings in the desert; their earthly focus on hunger and thirst leads them to believe slavery in Egypt would have been better than God's freedom for them. When we are struggling for whatever reason, it's easy to forget all that God has done for us in the past and all he desires to do for us in the future. We may not even recognize the very life-giving and life-sustaining "bread" that lays before us, much as the Israelites did not recognize the bread that lay before them in the desert. In spite of our hard-heartedness at times, however, God is truly patient; he loves us beyond measure. Just as he did not condemn the Israelites, he does not condemn us but rather, calls us back to him time and again with love and mercy.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

As we heard, God sends the people quail and manna - bread from heaven - to satisfy their frustrated longings while preparing them for an even greater "bread from heaven" that is still to come. In the Gospel, Jesus references this Scripture passage and clarifies that it was not Moses, but his Father who provided the bread from heaven. Jesus tells his disciples to "work for food that endures for eternal life" because he wants them to see the bigger picture. He wants them (and us!) to understand that we should not toil only for physical bread, but for the truest food that is lifegiving to our souls - the food found in accomplishing the works of God by believing and following the one he sent: Jesus. We do this by following Paul's advice from the second reading and seek to "be renewed in the spirit of [our] minds," following God's way of holiness. Only in and through this conformity to Christ will we be prepared to go forth and witness to the mystery of our faith.






