MESSAGE FROM FR DOOLEY

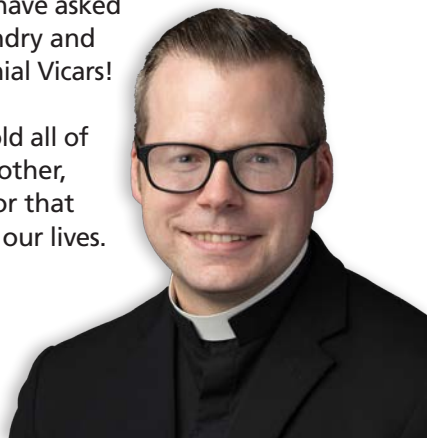

iTHIRST CERTIFICATION TRAINING

A new program, called iTHIRST, is an international initiative that aims to help dioceses, parishes, and communities provide vital support and resources for individuals and families who are impacted by various addictions. iTHIRST (which is an acronym for The Healing Initiative—Recovery, Spirituality, and Twelve Steps), was originally commissioned by Cardinal O'Malley of Boston, and is coming to the Diocese of Columbus. The iTHIRST certification program will train lay people, priests, religious, and deacons to offer spiritual support to those in our diocese impacted by addiction, ensuring that these individuals and their families do not have to face their struggles alone.

The certification, offered through Seton Hall University, begins on Monday, September 16, and will take place via Zoom every Monday and Wednesday evening for eight weeks. There is no homework, other than prayer and reflection! LIVING THE EUCHARIST IN DAILY LIFE,
BY IGNACIO REY NORES, SJ
(Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network)

When talking about the Eucharist, we talk about Jesus. He Himself is called the "Bread of Life," which nourishes, strengthens and sustains us. The Eucharist at Mass is a way to draw closer to Jesus, who strengthens us. But living our lives as a continuous "Eucharist" is something else. It transcends the Mass. The Eucharist invites us to not simply remain in the church building, but also to go out into the world.

We have to become aware of the hunger the world has. We, who want to be united with Jesus, the "Bread of Life," must see how Jesus had a special attention to the hunger of others. He recognized their spiritual hunger and how they were like sheep without a shepherd. The Eucharist invites us to look at the world as Jesus did and to realize their hunger.

United to Jesus, we can live as a "living thanksgiving" to the Father, and as "living bread" that is divided and distributed to satisfy the hunger and needs of the people around us. I invite you to consider yourself this way, as a "eucharist." May you feel called to recognize the different hungers of the world around you and that you are able to give yourself to others in generosity, making your life a continuous Eucharist.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Traditions are so important to us! They help define and preserve our heritage and our communities while also offering comfort and stability. They shape our human world as we see and live it. But in today's Gospel, Jesus scolds the Pharisees and scribes for allowing "the tradition of the elders" to drive them to hypocrisy: "In vain do they worship [the Lord], teaching as doctrines human precepts." He accuses them, saying "You disregard God's commandment but cling to human tradition." How could this be? Were the laws of ritual purity not important? They were, insofar as they were observed for the right reason: glorifying and honoring God, and being mindful of their covenantal relationship. We know, historically, that those who had questioned Jesus, leading to his response, were interested more in legalities, religious control, pride, and power. There was little "love for their neighbor" and a fair amount of "love for themselves." Therefore, Jesus is instructive when he tells them, "Nothing that enters one from the outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile." In other words: Ritual actions don't make us pure; the purity or impurity of our heart is what matters.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

What does it mean to be pure or impure of heart? Intentions matter; motivations matter. Jesus, quoting Isaiah, tells the Pharisees and scribes that they are honoring him with their lips but not their hearts; in other words, they were paying him "lip-service." "Oh those Pharisees!" we might say. They are easy to criticize and pontificate upon, aren't they? But how about us? It is worth looking at ourselves and honestly asking whether there might be times when we, too, are simply offering lip service to God? Are we truly offering him our hearts when we engage in our traditions and our activities? Our goal, as Jesus' disciples, is to be "doers of the word and not hearers only," as James puts it so succinctly in his letter. We are to hear God's word and commandments and then act on them in love.
