



St. Brendan Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2022 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

Currently, there are 50 full members and 10 associate members of St. Brendan St. Vincent de Paul Society. During the Fiscal Year October 1, 2021 September 30, 2022 members responded to 156 calls for assistance and assisted 448 individuals and family members. Parishioner monetary and in kind donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest parts of the diocese.
