## A Message from Fr Weldit

Dear St Brendan Family,

I hope you had a wonderful Christmas! I was blessed to celebrate with all of you, and in just a week, I will prepare to celebrate again with my community that follows the Eastern calendar.

Last week, we had the privilege of hosting a special guest from my home country of Eritrea, Bishop Fikremariam Hagos. His visit was a great blessing to our community. I had the opportunity to spend time with him, as did Bishop Fernandes, and I was deeply moved by the humility of both. During Advent, this humility—especially as we reflect on the humility of the Son of God—became a profound lesson for me.

Throughout Bishop Fikremariam's weeklong stay at the Chancery, he was greatly impressed by the warmth and care shown by Bishop Fernandes and all the Chancery staff. At the end of his stay, as Bishop Fikremariam bid farewell to Bishop Fernandes, I witnessed something truly special. Bishop Fernandes, with deep humility, asked Bishop Fikremariam to pray for him. It was such a profound moment as he bowed down for the prayer... it seemed as though his forehead might touch the ground! This simple act left a lasting impression on me, showing the power of true humility.

In this Christmas season, we are reminded that Jesus' birth itself is a powerful lesson in humility. Born into a humble family in Nazareth, placed in a manger because there was no room at the inn, Jesus left His heavenly kingdom to live amongst sinners. Despite being the King of Kings, He chose not to rule on Earth but to serve others. He humbled Himself by becoming a servant, teaching His disciples to follow His example and avoid seeking titles or positions of power. His birth, in fact, was a rebuke to the pride of the Israelite nation, who expected the Messiah to come as a mighty king.

In this season, I have been reminded of the humility that Jesus demonstrated from His birth to His death. His life continues to be a constant example of what true humility looks like.

Today, if there is anything that this Christmas season teaches us, it is to build each other up in humility. As Jesus dwelt amongst us in His servitude, He continues to dwell in our midst as the 'Immanuel' —God with us.

**WALK WITH ONE** 

**DO YOU STRUGGLE WITH PRAYER?** TAKE ADVICE FROM THE SAINTS! (Part One) - Sr. Kathryn J. Hermes

In the New Year, the hope is also to resolve to refine our prayer habits! This series will help us with some of the common struggles we may have in prayer.

There are many definitions of prayer, but they all point to one thing: love. Prayer is a relationship that tends towards an even closer union with the loved one. In his Catechism on Prayer, Saint John Vianney used a striking image to describe the union that prayer brings about: "Prayer is nothing else but a union with God.... In this intimate union, God and the soul are fused together like two bits of wax that no one can ever pull apart."

While there isn't a secret technique for praying better, there is a wisdom that the saints knew well: pray as you are able, trust in the unconditional love of God, and take the next best step to deepen your relationship with God.

If you're struggling with prayer right now, be gentle with yourself. Turn to the counsel of five saints to get your prayer back on track.

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux (1873-1897), the Carmelite nun known as The Little Flower and who is also a Doctor of the Church, struggled with staying awake while she prayed. For seven years she said she slept during her hours of prayer and her thanksgivings after Communion. The key to unlocking her spirituality, and the wisdom we can learn from her about praying, is this: We are little children before God who loves us immensely. Therefore, we can trust him to keep on loving us even when we struggle and fall. Thérèse wrote in her autobiography The Story of a Soul, "I remember that little children are as pleasing to their parents when they are asleep as well as when they are wide awake; I remember, too, that when they perform operations, doctors put their patients to sleep. Finally, I remember that: 'The Lord knows our weakness, that he is mindful that we are but dust and ashes.""



# Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

Sir 3:2-6, 12-14 | Col 3:12-21 | Lk 2:41-52

### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. These are the attributes Paul instructs the Colossians in today's reading to "put on" or to "clothe" themselves with. It's quite a list, isn't it? Paul goes on to talk about the virtues of the Christian family, which is fitting for today's Feast of the Holy Family. It is reasonable to expect, then, that the Gospel passage would follow through by expounding on the virtues of the perfect family: Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Instead, in Luke's Gospel, we have the only story in all of Scripture of Jesus' childhood. The only one that shows the specific interactions of them as a family - it tells the story of Jesus at age 12 who stays in Jerusalem without Mary and Joseph knowing and who are unable to find him for days. Prayerfully reflecting on this unique glimpse of the Holy Family working through misunderstandings, fear, and hurt helps us relate even more to the true humanness of Jesus and the Holy Family.

#### **GO EVANGELIZE**

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In the Holy Family, we see a model of relationship in human form. We are part of a holy family as well: we are children of God. And like Mary and Joseph, our family is enriched and strengthened when we are attentive to the presence of Jesus in our lives. Luke writes: "[Mary] kept all these things in her heart." Like Mary, let us strive to hold Jesus' words and commandments in our hearts so we can focus on God's divine plan for our lives. In the next line of Paul's letter offering us the "tools" for loving relationships (compassion ... patience) he adds, "bearing with one another and forgiving one another." In other words: love. We must put Jesus, who is love, at the center of our relationships and do everything in his name. Then our family, and our lives, will be holy indeed.




