

A Message from Jennifer Rice

Wait for the Lord, take courage; be stouthearted, wait for the Lord. ~Psalm 27:14

Waiting. How much time do we spend waiting in our lifetime? I have seen statistics of 37 hours spent waiting in line to waiting a total of six months per lifetime. Think about our daily waits in traffic, for appointments, food orders and more. Add to this the bigger things for which we wait: to know where you are going to college, to find our spouse, to have a child, to receive a diagnosis, to say good-bye to a loved one. The anticipatory anxiety that mounts during these periods of waiting can be overwhelming to our spirits. But there is another way.

In the Season of Advent, we are waiting on the Lord to arrive into our world again. We are encouraged to spend this time in quiet – difficult to achieve with the noise of the secular season, but also in our own heads which are prone to not doing well with waiting. Our minds fill with thoughts of to-do lists and worries, even when we are trying to be still and open. How do we wait for the Lord well?

In Psalm 27, there are clear instructions for us in waiting. "Dwell in the house of the Lord, gaze upon the Lord's beauty, be concealed in His shelter, shout with joy and praise, sing, seek His face, ask the Lord to show us the way and lead us on a level path..." He asks us to draw close to Him through spending time with His heart in prayer. Prayer is not just a platitude when we are struggling with waiting or quieting our minds from worry. Prayer is an action, a relationship builder, an intentional reaching for the One who has been faithful to us always and will do so again. Prayer can be in praise and thanksgiving, in admiration of His creation, in petition and intercession, in asking for guidance on the right path. When we are taking action in prayer, we are using the time of waiting well and the anxiety cannot help but diminish.

By this Second Sunday of Advent, I know many of you are trying to do one or more of the daily reflection programs or books out there, not always getting to check it off, not always focused on the words you are hearing. Me, too – I just want to soak it all up. But here is a challenge for me and for you – what if, as our priority this Advent, we just prayed a little more. We set aside extra minutes to pray in the morning, noon or night. To come and sit in the quiet of the church or chapel, to gaze upon Jesus and just listen. What if we waited on Him by waiting with Him? Imagine Jesus next to you as you wait. Imagine the courage and

strength that comes by simply being with Him. Breathe in the peace of this season that only comes from Jesus and let it fill you. While we wait for 16 days to pass until Christmas, we can wait with intention and peace.





EUCHARIST: BODY OF CHRIST BROKEN FOR THE WORLD, PART FOUR

The USCCB on the Eucharist as a social mission prompts us to look up the writings mentioned for even further study. This is the final part of the article:

The Eucharist challenges us to recognize and confront structures of sin. The Risen Christ in the Eucharist acts as "a compelling force for inner renewal, an inspiration to change the structures of sin in which individuals, communities and at times entire peoples are entangled" (St John Paul II, Dies Domini [On Keeping the Lord's Day Holy], no. 73). These structures include racism, violence, injustice, poverty, exploitation, and all other systemic degradation of human life or dignity. As Pope Benedict XVI reminds us, our "fraternal communion" in the Eucharist leads to "a determination to transform unjust structures and to restore respect for the dignity of all men and women, created in God's image and likeness" (Pope Benedict XVI, Sacramentum Caritatis [Sacrament of Charity], no. 89).

The Eucharist prepares us for mission. In the face of the sin and injustice we see present in our communities and in our world, the Eucharist "plants a seed of living hope in our daily commitment to the work before us," challenging us to live "Eucharistic" lives. It affirms our role as citizens and as men and women in various professions at different levels of society in "contributing with the light of the Gospel to the building of a more human world, a world fully in harmony with God's plan" (Ecclesia de Eucharistia, no. 20).

The Eucharist propels us forth to transform the world. The Eucharist "increases, rather than lessens, our sense of responsibility for the world today." Christ in the Eucharist calls us to build "a more human world, a world fully in harmony with God's plan" (Ecclesia de Eucharistia, no. 20). Filled with awe for all we have received in Christ's self-gift, we respond with service and works of charity. We act to transform unjust structures, policies, and laws that degrade human life and dignity.

How We Manage Snow on Campus

The Parish office remains open during regular hours, unless we reach a Level 2 Snow Emergency, in which case, the office will close.



Second Sunday of Advent

Bar 5:1-9 | Phil 1:4-6, 8-11 | Lk 3:1-6

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

On this second Sunday of Advent, when the hustle and bustle of the season is already upon us, I find Paul's words in his Letter to the Philippians very comforting. He says he is confident "that the one who began a good work in [us] will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus." Jesus will continue to be our Advocate and our Rock until the day he comes again. Yes, these are comforting words, indeed. But we know that being a disciple of Christ requires our cooperation and our daily assent to doing God's will. How do we know God's will for us? In his letter, Paul goes on to pray that our love may continue to increase in knowledge and perception "to discern what is of value." In other words, if we are going to be able to choose what is good, we must be able to recognize it and then focus on it.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

This is where "the voice of one crying out in the wilderness" speaks to us during this season in which we prepare for Christ's coming. It is a season of hope and anticipation, but it also must be a season of preparation. In today's Gospel, the proclamation of John the Baptist takes center stage; he proclaims a "baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins" and says to "prepare the way of the Lord." These words do not suggest passivity – waiting patiently for the Lord to come. They suggest action: Repent. Prepare. Make straight his paths. Today let us consider how we can prepare for the Lord's coming in our own lives. God has made us *good*, and he wants to bring that goodness to completion. As we continue in this Advent season, let us stay focused on recognizing and choosing "what is of value" in our lives so that we are able to truly rejoice that the Lord draws near.




