Message from Jacob Doran

This year, on January 1st, my wife and I renewed our consecration to Jesus through Mary. This is a prayer tradition in which a person pledges themselves to obedience to Jesus through the assistance of His Blessed Mother. Often, the consecration itself is preceded by a time of preparation, usually thirty-three days. The most famous of these preparations is by St Louis De Montfort. In my most recent case, my wife and I prepared using meditations by another great Marian Saint, Maximilian Kolbe.



Growing up, my family prayed the Rosary often. Sometimes during car rides, sometimes during Eucharistic Adoration, and there were even times we would do a Novena (nine consecutive days of praying the Rosary for a specific intention) as a family. While I wouldn't say that these practices gave me a great devotion to the Rosary or Mary, it did ground them as a foundational part of my prayer life. After leaving home, I always knew that I could pray a Rosary in times of need or struggle. Because of my parents, I know the prayers and mysteries of the Rosary. I know that Mary is always present as an intercessor and that she brings our prayers to her Son.

Over the years, I have prayed the Rosary less and less, partly because I've been learning other prayer practices, but there is still something in me that says, "pray the Rosary." In the days leading up to my consecration on January 1st, the celebration of Mary as the Mother of God, the desire to pray the Rosary rose within my heart. So, you could say that this brings to me a kind of New Year's Resolution, though it is really coincidental to the new calendar year. I want to pray the Rosary more, and especially for the families of St Brendan. My goal going forward is to begin each day of work in the Adoration Chapel praying a Rosary for your family and mine.


Please know that I am praying for you, and remember to pray for me, too. God bless you!

How We Manage Snow on Campus

Our snow contract stipulates that our parking lot is plowed only if we reach TWO INCHES or more of snowfall and is pretreated only if it is not raining. The parish facilities team is responsible for keeping the walkways cleared. When weather is inclement, be careful when walking around campus. Parish activities remain open if we are at a Level 1 Snow Emergency, but please consider whether you can safely reach the campus and attend events.

If a Level 2 Snow Emergency is declared, the entire campus closes, including Mass and all events. We will alert you via ParishStaq Communications and social media if this occurs. School parents will be alerted of any school closures or delays by FACTS communications. The Parish Office remains open during regular hours, but will close if we reach a Level 2 Snow Emergency.

**WALK WITH ONE**

**DO YOU STRUGGLE WITH PRAYER?
TAKE SOME ADVICE FROM THE SAINTS!
(Final, Part 3) - Sr Kathryn J. Hermes**

In the New Year, let's resolve to refine our prayer habits! This series will help us with some of the common struggles we may have in prayer:

When You Have No Time for Prayer
Brother Lawrence of the Resurrection (1614–1691), a disenchanted young soldier who entered the monastic life and was assigned for the remainder of his life to work in the kitchen and repair his brothers' sandals, is our guide here. In the book *The Practice of the Presence of God*, he explains his secret for practicing the presence of God no matter where he was or what he was doing: he held a conversation with God all the time. He talked to God about everything he was doing. When prayer needs to happen "on the go," so to speak, we can fold this conversation with God into our daily commute, the stirring of oatmeal, the searching for information online, and even checking our email or social media. Brother Lawrence's wisdom is this: "My only prayer practice is attention. I carry on a habitual, silent, and secret conversation with God that fills me with overwhelming joy."

When You Are Frustrated with Yourself
Saint Francis de Sales (1567–1622), bishop of Geneva and founder of the Sisters of the Visitation, wrote *Introduction to the Devout Life* as a guide for spiritual formation. One of the great secrets of Saint Francis is gentleness. He himself struggled with the tempests in his own heart for many years, gradually becoming someone who was known for his patience and his peace. This gentleness became the strongest characteristic of the wisdom he shared in his spiritual guidance and writing. We have to be gentle first with ourselves. It sometimes happens that when we find ourselves falling into a weakness or sin we get angry with ourselves, even berating ourselves. Instead, Francis de Sales urges us to deal quietly and patiently with ourselves, not being surprised at our weakness, for it is no surprise that the weak fall. He encourages us, "When you have fallen, lift up your heart in quietness, humbling yourself deeply before God by reason of your frailty. Heartily lament that you should have offended God, and begin anew to cultivate the lacking grace with a very deep trust in his mercy, and with a bold, brave heart."

January "Spiritual Spotlight"

"In the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those that are in heaven, on earth and under the earth" (Phil 2:10).

The month of January is dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus. After the Blessed Virgin Mary conceived by the Holy Spirit, the angel Gabriel appeared to St Joseph and told him that the Child's name should be called Jesus, meaning "God Saves." According to Jewish law, on the 8th day after his birth, a male child was to be circumcised, receive his name, and become a full member of God's covenant people. According to the old Roman liturgical calendar, the Feast of the Circumcision of Jesus was celebrated on January 1st, eight days after Christmas, the same day that He was given His sacred name. Currently, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Mother of God on January 1 and honor the Holy Name of Jesus on January 3. For Catholics, Jesus' sacred name is the object of a special devotion symbolized by the monogram "IHS," (sometimes called a Christogram), which is the first three letters of the Greek spelling of His name.

Please check out the Inviting Catholics Home "Spiritual Spotlight" bookshelf during January to find a variety of informative books about Jesus and feel free to take them home, read them, and share them with others. The bookmark inside the books this month features various prayers and interesting religious information about the month of January and Jesus that we hope you will enjoy!

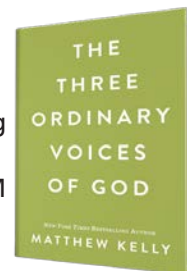

Young Couples/Young Parents Date Night!

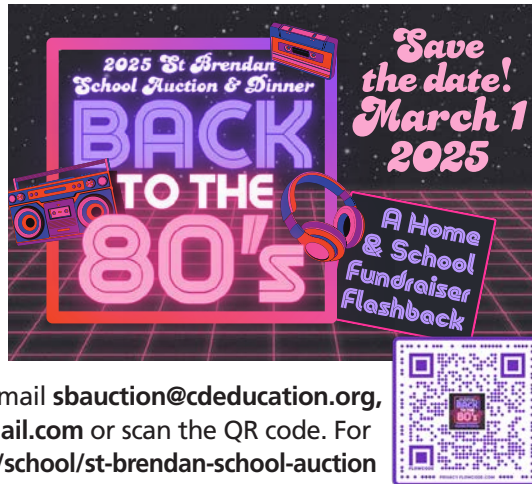
