Message from Kara Day

We have just concluded our annual *Spring Power and Love Retreat*. This is a high school retreat combined with many other youth groups across Columbus as a time for teens to encounter the power and love of our God. This year's theme was "Possible" and our prayer is that the teens would know that with God, anything is possible. Below are some of their encouraging testimonies from the weekend. I pray that these testimonies would encourage you to consider how you, too, can grow deeper in your faith and know that truly anything is possible with our all-powerful God!

"I came into retreat carrying a lot of hurt and an addiction that I felt I'd never get to see full healing from. Over the course of the weekend, through Confession and Adoration and prayer teams, I was able to feel the weight being lifted off of me. During prayer teams, specifically, there was an image of heavy chains being broken off of my hands and I could physically feel the weight of the hurt and pressure and addiction being lifted off of me, and I felt so much more free and so much more joyful for the first time in a long time."

"God has done so many amazing things during **Power and Love...** God was saying, "I have a plan for you: move forward." I just want to tell everyone that God has a plan for you. It may take 5 years or it could happen right now, but just trust God and He will make it happen."

"I started to give up hope that God would be able to heal me. I accepted that this would have to be something that I would have to live with. I went into **Power and Love** with so many questions about my health and about college. I went into **Power and Love** praying and knowing that Heaven would fall in adoration but I didn't know if it would fall on me. During Holy Hour, I heard the Lord saying to lay it all down at His feet. For the first time ever, I truly gave Him everything I had... I felt a wave of peace and a tingling sensation. I heard Him say to me, "You are healed, and this is your testimony." I felt the most happiness that I have ever felt in my entire life. I felt real, authentic joy that I have never felt before."

"I went into **Power and Love** this year in a strange place with the Lord. I didn't feel far from Him, nor did I feel close to Him, but I still was open to receiving what He had for me. Adoration Saturday evening was one of the most powerful ones I've experienced yet. I was told, "The Lord sees you. Your heart is the garden, let Jesus be the gardener." Jesus poured out so many graces into my heart through that. He met me where I was, and as I've gone throughout this week reflecting on all He did, I've been content in Him, I've learned how to rest in Him, and let the gardener tend to the garden of my heart."











"In the Eucharist, the Lord Speaks the Language of Love" (Part 3) by S. M. Marcelina Mikulska, CSFN, LPC, NCC

The Eucharist is the restorative fountain where we go to drink hope in God's power to save us, where we slake our thirst for God's love which overcomes evil and death. Those who yield to this grace will discover in the small, white host a captain at the helm of their lives who can rescue and revive them. He is! He is Jesus Christ! If we are willing to surrender to His plan, we discover in the Eucharist the One who helps us navigate our lives.

Before the tabernacle, there are 3 graces I pray for:

- 1. I ask to be a mentor like Jesus in the Eucharist, who is humble, meek, open to everyone, and characterized by goodness. It is not an easy task, yet this grace, I believe, is offered to us in the silence of Eucharistic Adoration.
- 2. I pray for insight to see beyond the issues raised by my clients in a session. I want them to be able to explore deeply what is ultimately true and good and real about their lives and God's love for them, as well as become proficient in the spiritual and psychological tools that will assist them in their search for wholeness. As my clients and I work together, we seek to integrate all the aspects of their lives within the search for the sacred, for meaning, development, purpose, and destiny. I truly believe that no matter what struggles we grapple with in our work together, we ultimately learn from Jesus that we can love even more than we ever thought possible.
- 3. It is in life-giving prayer before the Blessed Sacrament that I attend to my self-care, seeking balance in life. In my life as a consecrated religious, I need the grace of God to turn away from the disorder in my own heart, to go on the way proclaiming God's Kingdom, and to allow God to deepen His life within me.

In the end, in wonder before the power of Jesus in the Eucharist, I can only exclaim: Who will guide me to lift my eyes beyond my human understanding? Only the Lord! He is the One who guides and heals. I consider it a great mercy that the Lord has called me to work as a mental health counselor. In the Eucharist, we can trust that Jesus is with us along the way and sends us on a mission to communicate His unconditional love to the world.




