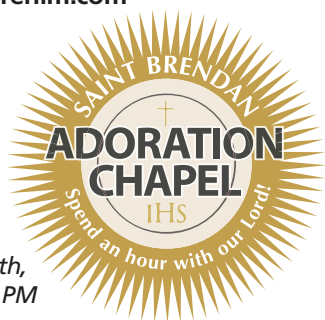

Message from Fr Dooley

Hello friends,

As I am writing this column, Pope Francis remains in critical condition at the Gemelli Hospital in Rome. We pray for his health and continued ministry as the shepherd of the Church.

Ash Wednesday is this week. Please join us for Mass at 7 AM, 12 PM (Noon) and 5:30 PM. The Distribution of Ashes will take place at all the Masses. Please note that non-Catholics and anyone, regardless of age, can receive ashes. We hear the same readings every year for Ash Wednesday. The Gospel from Matthew provides us with a "blueprint" of what to do during this Season of Lent. As Jesus tells His disciples: pray, fast, and give alms. Here are some practical suggestions for each of these this Lenten Season:

1) Pray– Lent is the perfect time for us to rededicate our prayer time with the Lord. I find the morning to be the best time to collect oneself and prepare for the day. The Sunday Mass readings are a great springboard for your prayer life and they can help you to engage with Mass even more. I'm taken aback by how much is offered here in our parish. Please take advantage of our Masses, Eucharistic Adoration, Stations of the Cross, and the many opportunities for Confession this Lenten Season.

2) Fast– This is a tough one. Our Lord Himself fasted for 40 days and 40 nights. We can fast from our favorite foods and give up meat on Fridays. Whatever we fast from this Lent, we are called to focus on our dependence on God and not our own resources. As a gentle reminder, the Church states the following: "For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards."

3) Giving Alms– We are called to provide for the poor and help those in most need. I invite you to contribute or join our active St Vincent de Paul Society. The needs are great in our wider community. Another good way to give alms is your time. This Lent is the perfect time to call or a visit a family member, friend, or someone that you have lost contact with over the years.

I look forward to spending my first Lent with you as your pastor.

I pray that we will seize every opportunity to recognize the sacrificial love of our Savior, Jesus Christ.

March "Spiritual Spotlight"

Stations of the Cross - The Lenten Story!

The Stations of the Cross tell the story of Jesus' path to Calvary and the distress He endured as He walked to His crucifixion on our behalf.

Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sir 27:4-7 | 1 Cor 15:54-58 | Lk 6:39-45

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

It can be uncomfortable to admit, but our speech habits can truly reveal our interior life. Too often, I've fallen prey to the temptation of gossip or other alluring but unbecoming forms of conversation. Perhaps we all have to some degree, which is why today's words from Sirach capture our attention: "When a sieve is shaken, the husks appear; so do one's faults when one speaks." This theme of speech being connected to our hearts is woven throughout Scripture, and it both challenges and encourages us. Before God came to us in the flesh, he came to us as the *Word*. Our words carry eternal weight; they have the power to bless or to curse. For this reason, the Scriptures today challenge us to seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit, our Advocate, in order to grow in virtue so that our speech may reflect his glory and our words echo his truth.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's parable from Luke's Gospel, Jesus asks, "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?" Ouch. Am I the only one who shifts uncomfortably when reading this? How often and how easily do we fixate on the way others have caused us frustration, discomfort, or hurt? While those things may (or may not) be true, it feels so easy to dismiss personal responsibility. In this passage, Jesus lovingly teaches us that when we live this way, we remain stuck in our patterns of sin. But he also gives us another option: "Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly." It is through this honest examination of conscience and cleansing of our own sin that we come to know God more fully, and as our vision is cleared, become more aware of how his beauty and mercy surround us.

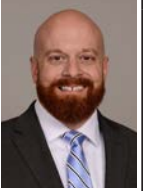
