A Message from Deacon Jim Morris

Lent came a bit early this year, at least it seemed to me that it did, and we are now about halfway through it for this year.

One theme that I've been thinking about is sacrifice and its dual component of gratitude. They are interrelated – sacrifice is the

expression of our gratitude, and gratitude is our spiritual sacrifice.

This theme started in our readings from the First Sunday of Lent when Moses was reminding his people of what God had done for them and what their response should be:


"He brought us out of Egypt with his strong hand and outstretched arm, with terrifying power, with signs and wonders; and bringing us into this country, he gave us this land flowing with milk and honey. 'Therefore, I have now brought you the first fruits of the products of the soil which you, O LORD, have given me.' And having set them before the Lord, your God, you shall bow down in his presence."

Both sacrifice and gratitude.

Sacrifice means and expresses three things:

- Our humble acknowledgement that all the good in the universe and all the good in our lives is from God, from His grace – that we are totally dependent on Him.
- The physical sacrifices we make symbolizes the spiritual sacrifice we need to make in gratitude to God. Our parting with some of our physical gifts, a little bit of our "stuff," expresses our willingness to sacrifice our self-interest, our egotism, in love of God.
- Our sacrifices also express our union with Christ and His sacrifice, the sacrifice He offered of Himself on the cross, to the Father, for our salvation. Lent is a great time to think about all that God has given each of us. If we love God, if we are truly grateful, we will love making sacrifices for Him.

It's not really as hard as we seem to make it. Start with little things: one minute to really listen to your friends or your family, one minute to pray during a busy day, one little extra thoughtfulness to those we encounter. Make it a habit, and you will gradually experience its joy – the joy of achievement, the joy of creating a work of spiritual art, and the joy of doing (as Mother Teresa put it) "something beautiful for God."





Living a Eucharistic Life during Lent (Part 1) by Sr. Mary Catherine Kasuboski, TOR

What do we do when we want to give someone a gift, but have no money? We usually have to get creative, and often the result is a gift that includes something of ourselves.

For many years, I have served our community as the General Treasurer, which means I manage the material resources for the whole community. It is a role that involves a massive amount of responsibility, leaving me very little time to devote to our communal ministries. However, I feel within me a deep hunger to do ministry, because I didn't enter religious life to take care of the finances.

A Hidden Opportunity

Recently, after a couple of ministry events came up for me and subsequently fell through, I felt rather disappointed.
As I took my still hungry heart to the Lord, I felt led to consider my present circumstances replete with ministry opportunities, not to people outside the community, but to my own sisters with whom I live.

At first, I didn't find this very exciting, but when I began to accept it more deeply, I realized the Lord was offering me opportunities to live a Eucharistic life at every moment of every day—offering a gift of myself in little, often hidden ways that might never be considered "ministries" by anyone else. If a sister comes to my office needing a check to purchase something and I give her a loving smile with it, I have given a gift of myself.

When we are at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we witness Jesus offering Himself to the Father as He did on the Cross, and we are called to participate in that by offering ourselves (and all aspects of our lives) with Jesus to the Father. When we leave Mass, we are called to extend that self-offering and live a Eucharistic life by offering ourselves to one another in love.



Third Sunday of Lent

Ex 3:1-8a, 13-15 | 1 Cor 10:1-6, 10-12 | Lk 13:1-9

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Meaningful human relationships rarely last if only one party makes an effort to maintain a connection. The same is true in our relationship with God. In the scene recorded in today's first reading - arguably one of human history's "Top Ten" most important events - God takes the initiative, but the encounter is two-sided. God causes the bush to burn and Moses approaches; God calls Moses and he responds, "Here I am!"; finally, Moses asks God his name and God reveals himself as "I am who am." Moses' cooperation with God throughout is essential for them to arrive at this monumental revelation which would allow Moses (and, by extension, all of the Israelites) to call upon God by name. Despite our many technological achievements, a free, generous, loving response to God's initiative is still the only "fruit" we can bear for him that he cannot procure himself. This is the fruit which the fig tree in Jesus' Gospel parable is meant to produce. If we truly desire and seek this relationship, God will reveal himself to us so that, no matter our stage or state of life, we can bear this fruit even now.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In his encounter with God, Moses exhibits an exemplary combination of boldness and humility which teaches us how we should approach our relationship with God. This is our "roadmap" which will help us fertilize the "ground" of our hearts. Consider Moses' bold, inquisitive spirit: "I must go over to look at this remarkable sight," and his prompt response to God's call: "Here I am!" Consider the audacity Moses must have had to ask God for his name. At the same time, however, consider his humility in removing the sandals from his feet and hiding his face before the majesty of God. The God who revealed himself to Moses is the same God who invites us into relationship with him. We can and should have Moses' boldness to ask God to teach us about himself. But we should also approach God with a spirit of reverence and awe. Our humility will be the fertile soil that God can use to make us his intimate friends and his representatives before others.
