St. Brendan Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2024 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

Currently, there are 24 full members and 37 associate members of St. Brendan's St. Vincent de Paul Society. During the Fiscal Year October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024 members responded to 229 calls for assistance. Parishioner's monetary and "in kind" donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest parts of the diocese.
