Dr. Dufault is fine with us doing something hybrid on our own for older grades. R Factor Update - 6 teachers and Mr. DeMassimo completed training. Now they will roll out to staff. April/May - will start with some high level. Then in August will go more in depth. Then will continue on through the year and feel out when we are ready to roll out to kids. Might be at the end of next year or the following. Enrichment Opportunities - have evaluated some of these ideas - formal gifted programs are a beast. Reading programs - we have many staff that could potentially help with this and provide some opportunities. Club program is very robust for next year. School Newspaper starts next week.
