

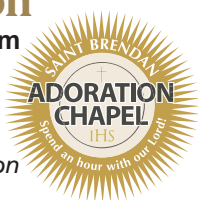

Message from Maggie Cook

Amid the hustle of soccer tournaments, graduations, and the end of the school year, it can be easy to forget that the month of May is set aside to honor our universal Mother, Mary. Instead of trying to write my own reflection of her, I decided to turn to someone whose words are certainly more profound: St John Paul II. Below is an excerpt from *Redemptoris Mater* (par. 46), an encyclical written by John Paul on the Blessed Virgin Mary.



For every Christian, for every human being, Mary is the one who first "believed," and precisely with her faith as Spouse and Mother she wishes to act upon all those who entrust themselves to her as her children. And it is well known that the more her children persevere and progress in this attitude, the nearer Mary leads them to the "unsearchable riches of Christ" (Eph. 3:8). And, to the same degree, they recognize more and more clearly the dignity of man in all its fullness and the definitive meaning of his vocation, for "Christ...fully reveals man to man himself. [Gaudium et Spes, 22]"

This Marian dimension of Christian life takes on special importance in relation to women and their status. In fact, femininity has a unique relationship with the Mother of the Redeemer, a subject which can be studied in greater depth elsewhere.* Here I simply wish to note that the figure of Mary of Nazareth sheds light on womanhood as such by the very fact that God, in the sublime event of the Incarnation of his Son, entrusted himself to the ministry, the free and active ministry of a woman. It can thus be said that women, by looking to Mary, find in her the secret of living their femininity with dignity and of achieving their own true advancement. In the light of Mary, the Church sees in the face of women the reflection of a beauty which mirrors the loftiest sentiments of which the human heart is capable: the self-offering totality of love; the strength that is capable of bearing the greatest sorrows; limitless fidelity and tireless devotion to work; the ability to combine penetrating intuition with words of support and encouragement.

Just as St John Paul II often encouraged us to do, let us turn to Mary with our whole hearts and cry, "Totus Tuus" (totally yours)!

"A Mother's Faith"

Part 2 of 2: Learning to Let Go in Trust

So, I did it: I surrendered. I continue to work on doing it every day.

Nightly, I prayed the Surrender novena: "Lord, I surrender it all to you; take care of everything." At the hospital, I said the Rosary daily. I went to Mass. At some point, Marjorie's cardiologist told us her surgery had failed, and he asked us if we wanted to wait and see how she would do down the line. Or did we want to try for a riskier, second open-heart surgery at another hospital in another state? I had to give it all to the Lord. I, a little suburban girl, teacher, mother, and lover of travel and books and dancing, was not the least bit qualified to make this grand medical decision. So, we talked to the surgeons, we weighed our options, we prayed, we made a decision, and I let go. I trusted.

Like Mary. When the angel came to her and told her she was going to be the Theotokos, the God-bearer, she didn't have all the answers. She didn't know how it was all going to unfold. She asked, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" (Lk 1:34). But, she unconditionally trusted. She had complete faith.

"May it be done to me according to your word" (Lk 1:38).

Her fiat, her "yes" to doing God's will, was and is my inspiration. While far from the perfection of Mary, I can strive to be like our beautiful Mother when I receive the Eucharist, Christ's Body and Blood. Mary unquestionably is the ideal mother, abandoned and docile to God's will. But I can strive to be like her when I say yes to that which I didn't ask for and to do it with love and joy. I can be sustained in my faith, in my life's journey, through the nourishment of the Eucharist, the bread for the journey. I can carry Jesus in me, just like she did. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn 6:56).

What an incredible trade for control!

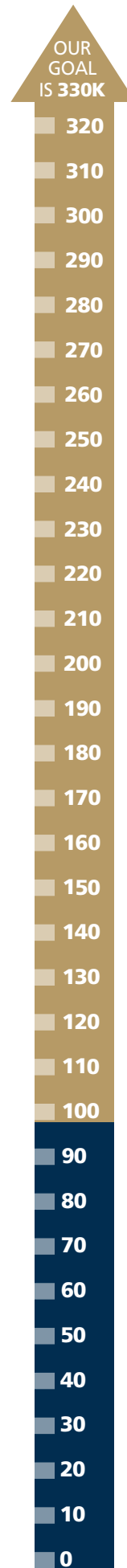
Leadership Positions Needed for Festival '25

Fifth Sunday of Easter

Acts 14:21-27 | Rev 21:1-5a | Jn 13:31-33a, 34-35

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's Gospel occurs shortly before Jesus gives his Last Supper Discourses in the Gospel of John. Judas has betrayed Jesus, and now the Lord speaks to his inner circle for one of the last times before his arrest. "I will be with you only a little while longer," he says. At these words, I imagine a hush falling over the group. Rattled by Judas' strange actions and alarmed by the Lord announcing his impending departure, the disciples' eyes must have darted about as they held their breath, awaiting Jesus' words. "I give you a new commandment," he says. "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." In a word, Jesus summarizes his teaching: love as God loves. He is using these last moments to exhort his disciples to be as he is. We know it won't be easy - it will involve sacrifice and suffering - but the Holy Spirit is present with us to guide and advocate for us on our journey.

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

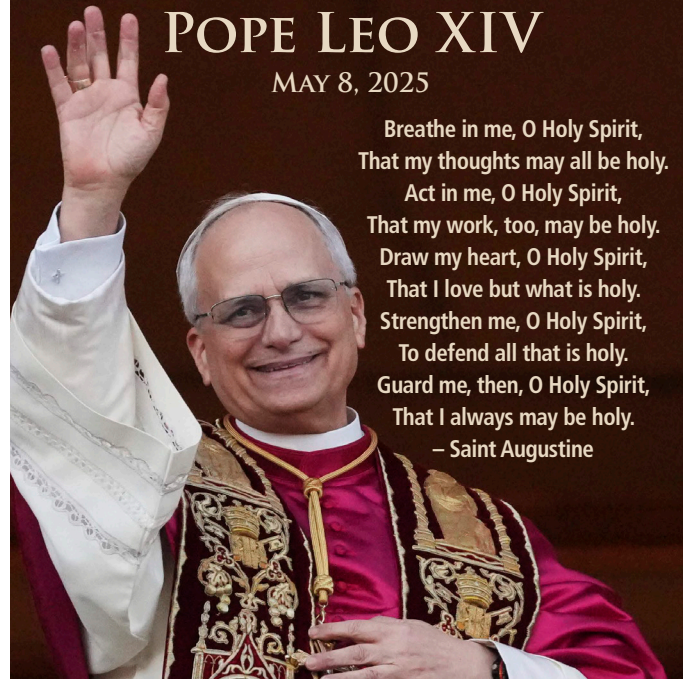
Have you ever experienced a season of suffering and wondered, "Have I done something wrong?" When we meet resistance on the narrow path, it can make us question our choices, ourselves, and sometimes even God. Let today's first reading be a boost of confidence on your journey; remember that your suffering does not imply a misstep. "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God," Paul and Barnabas exhort the disciples (and us). It is natural to grow fatigued, especially when we encounter hardships. This is one reason why the Lord desires that we never journey alone. By God's perfect design, humans require companionship, from other humans and from the Creator himself. In the reading from the Book of Revelation, John the Apostle hears a loud voice saying, "God himself will always be with them as their God." Though the road may be peppered with pain, and the trials overwhelming, may we never forget that our God is very near!

Pope Leo XIV was born September 14, 1955, in Chicago, Illinois. He holds a bachelor's degree from the Augustinian-run Villanova University in Pennsylvania and joined the order in 1977, making his solemn vows in 1981.

He joined the Augustinian mission in Peru in 1985 and largely worked in the country until 1999 when he was elected head of the Augustinians' Chicago-based province. From 2001 to 2013, he served as prior general of the worldwide order. In 2015, Pope Francis named him bishop of Chiclayo, in northern Peru, and the pope asked him also to be apostolic administrator of Callao, Peru, from April 2020 to May 2021.

Pope Francis elevated him to Cardinal in the Consistory of September 30, 2023, when he was assigned Cardinal of St. Monica. On February 6, 2025, Pope Francis promoted him to the highest degree of Cardinals, granting him the title of the Suburbicarian Church of Albano.

On May 8, 2025, Cardinal Protodeacon Dominique Mamberti pronounced the formula, "Habemus Papam," proclaiming to the city of Rome and to the whole world the news of the election of Robert Francis Cardinal Prevost as Pope Leo XIV.
