A Message from Fr Dooley

Hello friends.

May is a joyful and busy month as we celebrate many joyous occasions for our parishioners and school children. We entrust our prayers especially to the Blessed Virgin Mary this month.

Papal Conclave – The Catholic Church has officially concluded the nine days of mourning for Pope Francis, or also called, the *Novendiales*. This is an ancient Christian and Roman custom that includes prayers and Masses said around the world for the deceased pope. I encourage you to watch Pope Francis' Funeral Mass and the transfer of his body to St Mary Major Basilica in Rome. It was truly beautiful to watch the city of Rome come out and pray for Pope Francis.

The College of Cardinals has announced that the Papal Conclave is to begin on Wednesday, May 7. Back in 2013, the cameras showed the Litany of Saints procession of the College of Cardinals to the Sistine Chapel. It is truly a sight to behold showing the traditions of the Church. Please pray for the College of Cardinals as a new pope and pastor is chosen for the Church.

First Holy Communion – Please keep the children of our parish and school in your prayers as they celebrate their First Holy Communion on Sunday, May 4 and Sunday, May 11. There are 110 children receiving their First Holy Communion this year! (Yes, I'm still getting used to being a pastor of a mega-parish). We pray that our children and their families may be invigorated by the Holy Eucharist in their lives.

Confirmation – Bishop Earl K Fernandes will be present on Friday, May 9 to bestow the Sacrament of Confirmation on our 8th graders in the parish and school. The Confirmandi class is at 90. Come, Holy Spirit!

Fr Weldit: Retreat & Vacation – Fr Weldit will be gone for a well-deserved retreat and vacation from Monday, May 19 until Saturday, May 31. I am grateful to minister with Fr Weldit! Essentially, during this time, I will be the only priest "on the ground" here at St Brendan. I was able to get Mass coverage for some of our daily Masses. Please consult the bulletin carefully this month for our daily Mass schedule since we are down two priests and our end-of-the-school-year liturgies are happening for our school children. Please pray for me and for more priestly vocations.

Weddings – I am honored to celebrate two weddings this month! First, Paul Roth and Brenna Schoen are getting married on Saturday, May 10. Then, Peyton Huth and Maria Simonton on Saturday, May 31. Please pray for them and all couples preparing for marriage.

We also have wedding bells in the Parish Office! Our own Maggie Cook (Family Faith Formation Coordinator) married Joshua Cook back in December at Holy Family Parish. Next up, Kara Day (VINE High School Youth Minister) just got married to Alex Shand this weekend at St John Neumann in Sunbury. Help Bring People into the Catholic Church!



Catholic dioceses across the US reported significant growth in the number of new Catholics entering the Church this Easter, with some archdioceses welcoming their largest groups in years.

Praise God, we are experiencing a high number of people inquiring about the Catholic faith here, too! In order to help them discern their call to faith, we need to be ready to receive them in OCIA. Here's how you can help:

Team members – welcome, facilitate discussion, present topics (if comfortable), pray! We will have separate groups running sessions on Tuesday nights, one starting in June and another in September.

Sponsors – many of those seeking the Church have no connection to Catholicism and will need a sponsor who can attend the sessions and walk alongside the person in their discernment. Usually a 6-month commitment with follow-up on your own.

Childcare volunteers – Several of our potential OCIA attendees have infants or young children. Having childcare on site will allow them to fully participate in the process. Adults (current PGC on file) and teens needed!

Respect Life/Disabilities Awareness in May!

When you hear the words "Respect Life," who are the first people that come into your mind? Usually the babies. Sometimes the dying. Yet, our Catholic faith implores us to consider ALL human life as sacred, regardless of age, gender, illness...or disability. This month, the Respect Life Ministry focuses on increasing awareness and prayers for all of those with a physical or mental disability – to recognize every person we encounter as a child of God, created in His image – and to look beyond whatever brokenness we may perceive on the outside and see the soul, the heart of the person. It is the same thing our Father does for us. He looks past our brokenness to see the blessing of the child He loves beyond measure, for we are all broken in some way.

Our Knights of Columbus council provides support to people with developmental disabilities through their annual "Measure Up" Drive. A majority of these funds collected in May go to support Special Olympics Ohio, including Hilliard Special Olympics.

Did you know Special Olympics is more than just about athletics? The Special Olympics *Healthy Athletes Program*, which started in 1997, has:

- Provided more than one million comprehensive health screenings to Special Olympic athletes in the United States.
- Trained over 130,000 health care professionals to increase knowledge of best practices in caring for people with intellectual disabilities.
- Healthy Athletes Software (HAS) is the largest database of health data for people with intellectual disabilities in existence.
- Contributed to establishment of the American Academy of Developmental Medicine and Dentistry.

Parking Lot Safety Updates

To create a safer environment for children around our school playground, we added two permanent asphalt speed bumps on the road in between the playground and DiPietro Fields. (Note: We heard you! – the first speed bumps installed have been reduced down in height.) The area shown in yellow on the graphic to the right is now designated as a "No Parking Fire Zone." The parking spots there will be eliminated as soon as the Fire Zone striping is completed. As a reminder, the speed limit throughout our parking lot is only 10 mph. 




