Message from Kara Shand



Happy Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity and Happy Father's Day! It is an incredible mystery that our God is three Persons in one God. Today, on Father's Day, I am reminded what a gift it is that one of the persons of the Trinity is God the Father because even when God can seem far off and distant, fathers are familiar to us and can show us what God the Father is like.

It can be challenging sometimes to know how we ought to relate to the Trinity as mere humans. After all, God created all the universe! Our Psalm in Mass today first calls to mind how big and powerful our God is when it reads, "O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth! When I behold your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars which you set in place..." and then the Psalm draws attention to the fact of our littleness when it goes on, "What is man that you should be mindful of him?" David poses a good question in this Psalm: What is man in light of the almighty, all-powerful God who created all things?

How do we as humans relate to a God who is so powerful and big? The name of the first person of the Trinity helps us to know. Like a son or a daughter to a Father.

You have a Heavenly Father who desires to love you and be a good Father to you. God wants to be your protector, your provider, your helper, and your security. He is the giver of all good things, and like a child you can rely on your Father for everything and always turn to Him for help, guidance, and mercy.

A father is someone you can believe in, trust in, and love. Regardless of your experience with your earthly father, God the Father desires to be the perfect Father in heaven for you. Our earthly Fathers are meant to reflect this character of God to us in our daily lives, and we can come to know God more through their love!

On this Trinity Sunday and Father's Day, I encourage you to spend some time building your relationship with the first person of the Trinity, God the Father. How can you grow in relating to God as your Father? Spend some time in prayer today letting Him love you as His child. The *Our Father* that Jesus taught us to pray is a great place to start!

Spend some time thinking about what earthly father figures in your life have shown you more about who God is. Be sure to reach out and thank them for reflecting God the Father to you!



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Prov 8:22-31 | Rom 5:1-5 | Jn 16:12-15

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Between two people who love each other, speech often gives way to silence. But first, in order to nourish love, there must be a mutual exchange of words. Persons in love wish to share their most intimate secrets so that they might know and be known. In an act deserving of our endless wonder, God disclosed his most intimate secret to us: He is a communion of Persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — who relate to each other in an eternal exchange of love. St. Thomas Aquinas insisted that the Trinity is not a reality we could have figured out on our own (in contrast to, for example, God's existence — which we can know simply by examining creation). God had to *reveal* his Trinitarian nature to us. While humanity was wandering further and further away from him over the millennia after the Fall, God was preparing us for the revelation of the Son and the Holy Spirit. This is what Jesus is announcing in today's Gospel: "Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that [the Holy Spirit] will take from what is mine and declare it to you." To his bewildered disciples, Jesus is expressing God's intention to communicate his identity to us — an unmerited gift which he offers simply because he loves us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

This is our inheritance as Christians: God has revealed himself to us out of love. Once we've assented to this truth, we can no longer dismiss the mystery of the Holy Trinity as "above my theological paygrade." One who loves is not bothered that the beloved always remains a mystery; instead, he or she is content to remain in wonder and seeks to enter more deeply into the exchange of love. For us, this means responding to God's gift of himself with reverence, gratitude, and obedience to his will. We approach him in prayer with the respectful but confident attitude of a child who knows itself to be deeply loved; we listen to him, express our thanksgiving for his gift, and seek to know his will for us.

PRAY

Be attentive to the ways God is revealing himself and his love for you in your daily life. Discover that *everything* is an expression of his care: answered prayers, a kind word given or received, the beauty of nature — even crosses which induce us to turn to him for help! Take a few minutes each day to thank God for his gifts.
