

## A Message from Fr Weldit

#### **CORPUS CHRISTI IN THE ERITREAN CATHOLIC TRADITION:**

"Take, eat; this is my body... Drink of it, all of you; for this is my blood" (Matthew 26:26–28)

Today, we celebrate the great Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ—a feast that draws our hearts deeper

into the mystery of the Eucharist, the very center of our Catholic faith. In the Divine Liturgy, Christ offers not a mere symbol, but Himself—fully and completely: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This solemnity holds special significance in the Eritrean Catholic Church, which follows the ancient Alexandrian Ge'ez Rite and is in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church. For Eritrean Catholics, the Eucharist is not only the summit of worship, but also a source of strength for a people who have long known both suffering and faithfulness.

On the feast of Corpus Christi, the Divine Liturgy (Qidasse) is celebrated with liturgical richness, profound reverence and joyful devotion. The liturgy is sung in the ancient Ge'ez language, accompanied by the resonant beat of drums and the bright jingle of senasel (liturgical sistrums). Worshipers, clothed in traditional white garments—zuria for women and shamma for men—fill the church with a prayerful and vibrant spirit of community. One of the most moving aspects of the celebration is the Eucharistic procession. The Blessed Sacrament is reverently carried beneath a beautifully adorned canopy, as the faithful walk in procession around the church or through the surrounding streets.

John, Chapter 6 (referred to as the Bread of Life Discourse) provides the theological foundation for this devotion. In this passage, Jesus speaks of the necessity of eating His flesh and drinking His blood to have eternal life. Though many may not be able to recite the chapter by heart, they live its truth through their actions in the procession. This chapter also recounts a turning point: many of Jesus' followers leave Him, unable to accept this hard teaching—yet those who remain, like the faithful in these processions, bear witness to their belief through visible acts of worship.

During the procession, children scatter flowers, women ululate in joy and hymns of thanksgiving rise to heaven. In some villages, the procession flows through the entire main street, symbolizing that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life—the very center of their faith. Each time the church bell rings, all movement halts, and the faithful pause to adore the Eucharist. These moments of stillness speak volumes—profound expressions of reverence and awe. The procession is far more than a tradition; it is a living proclamation of faith, a visible sign of Christ's presence among His people. The rising incense from the censers symbolizes the prayers of the faithful being lifted to God, making the entire experience both sacred and communal.

After the liturgical celebration, Eritrean Catholic communities often gather for a festive meal. Families share traditional dishes like injera (sourdough flatbread) and zigni (spicy meat stew), while elders offer blessings and recount stories of faith. It is a time of joy, hospitality, and cultural pride—a reflection of the unity and love that flow from the Eucharist itself.

Corpus Christi reminds us all—whether Eritrean, American, from east or west—that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. He nourishes our souls and calls each of us to become His living Body in the world.





## The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Gen 14:18-20 | 1 Cor 11:23-26 | Lk 9:11b-17

#### GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's feast is set apart to reverence the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist. In our limited human capacity, this concept can feel abstract, and we may struggle to understand it. In these moments, I find that pondering the person of Jesus Christ in the Gospels illuminates my mind and heart. Hearing the familiar story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes in today's Gospel, I'm particularly struck by the first line of the passage: "Jesus spoke to the crowds about the kingdom of God, and he healed those who needed to be cured." Notice that Luke doesn't say that Jesus heals everyone, rather, he heals those who need to be cured. This is not an act of favoritism, but a revelation of his perfect divine wisdom and a glimpse into the true person of Jesus Christ. In his great mercy and perfect love, Jesus knew instantly what each person needed. And this Jesus, who came to heal and cure, is the one we receive in the Eucharist today.

#### **GO EVANGELIZE**

#### PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's feast is a reminder of the staggering truth that 2,000 years later, at every Eucharistic celebration in Catholic churches around the world, Christ becomes truly present. The same Jesus of the Gospels who taught the crowds, multiplied the loaves, and gave himself completely on the cross, gives himself to us *today:* body, blood, soul, and divinity. We are not unlike the crowds in today's Gospel — we have come with our hopes and needs to encounter Jesus. Today, at this table, no one goes hungry; Jesus meets our needs by giving us his unconditional love while nourishing us both physically and spiritually. We can be reassured that God is always present in our lives.


