A Message from Jennifer Rice



COME, HOLY SPIRIT...

During my prayer time, I light a candle that has two wood wicks. The wood wicks give a comforting crackling sound, but even more fascinating is watching them burn. The wicks glow like an ember, then, every so often, a flame pops up. It is mesmerizing.

The Holy Spirit operates in a similar fashion in each of us. As we celebrate Pentecost this weekend, we are reminded of the power of the Spirit in our lives and are encouraged to seek this out. At Baptism we receive the Holy Spirit, and He burns in our hearts like

embers, waiting for something to stir the flame. With each Sacrament, prayer, and act of faith and love, the flame ignites. At Confirmation the Holy Spirit catches fire again as we receive Him fully along with the gifts of wisdom, understanding, knowledge, fortitude, piety, counsel and fear of the Lord. These gifts are meant to take root as we now grow into our faith and discern the spiritual gifts that will shape our vocations.

Yet it is in the everyday that the Lord asks us to consider calling upon the Holy Spirit to fan the embers into a flame. Recently, I led a Communion service at one of our assisted living facilities. The Gospel readings all that week had Jesus explaining to the apostles Who and what was going to happen next: *But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears and will declare to you the things that are coming* (John 16:13). I reflected with our small gathering on the gift that Jesus gave upon His departure. The Holy Spirit comes to guide us. When we are lost, needing a little nudge, when we need confirmation of the next good and right thing, we only need call for the Holy Spirit. *Come, Holy Spirit* is the short version and an easy prayer to remember. I encouraged the residents to pray this in their need. You will often hear this as someone starts to lead intercessory prayer as well – a calling down of the Holy Spirit to guide the prayer, the words, to provide His consolations.

The next part of the Holy Spirit prayer calls to mind our opening image: *...fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.* Stir the ember into a flame. Pentecost signifies the end of the Easter season and a foray into Ordinary Time, but the Easter season is meant to continue in our hearts. The fire that was stirred can thrive with an intentional focus on calling upon the Holy Spirit to shake up our spiritual lives, to not be lulled into complacency and lukewarm faith. We should ask the Holy Spirit every day to show us what needs to be done in our lives and in the lives of others we are meant to encounter, love and evangelize: *Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth.*

My encouragement to you this Pentecost, is to welcome the Holy Spirit as your guide and allow Him to ignite those embers into a stronger flame of faith. It starts with just asking, *Come, Holy Spirit.*

O God, who have taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that in the same Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

In June we celebrate many feast days: Ascension (June 1), Pentecost (June 8), Most Holy Trinity (June 15), Corpus Christi (June 22), the Sacred Heart of Jesus (June 27), the Immaculate Heart of Mary (June 28), and Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul (June 29). God is Love and the Sacred Heart of Jesus, present to us in the Blessed Sacrament, is the human manifestation of God's Love for us. June is also the month for weddings, where human hearts join and bring forth new life, through our Creator's cooperation. The family is a human reflection of the Blessed Trinity. To bring all these messages into focus, the Spiritual Spotlight this month will provide books about Mary, family and love, for you to take, read, and share. Our June bookmarks provide a prayer for Mary's intercession as well as information about St Anthony of Padua, whose feast day is June 13.

On this Pentecost Sunday, please join us in praying this Prayer to the Holy Spirit:

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth.

Lord, by the light of the Holy Spirit you have taught the hearts of your faithful. In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

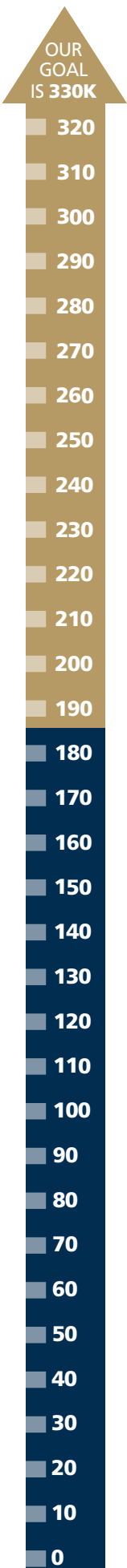

Pentecost Sunday

Acts 2:1-11 | 1 Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13 | Jn 20:19-23 or Jn 14:15-16, 23b-26

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

In today's first reading, we join the Apostles in the Upper Room. These individuals had accompanied Jesus to his death and been witnesses to his resurrection and ascension. Can you imagine the throes of emotion accompanying each experience? Now, they gather together, perhaps discussing what to do next. They wonder where they should go, and who they should listen to, since Jesus was no longer there: "And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind." In a moment swelling with grace, tongues of fire descended upon each person present, "and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit." What might this moment have sounded like? Looked like? Felt like? The Apostles were weary and grieving, but Jesus made a promise he intended to keep — that he would send an advocate in his name to teach them everything. That same Spirit now waits to guide and empower us if we are willing to receive him.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Jesus' death left his followers grieving and disoriented. They had left everything to follow him. And now, he was gone. What would become of them? Jesus said: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." On this feast of Pentecost, Jesus' promise is fulfilled. When the Father sent down the Spirit, it was not just for a singular, grand moment in time; the Spirit came for good. In the same way the Apostles were strengthened by the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, so were we strengthened at our confirmation. We were commissioned, as were they, to live out our faith in the world. When we need strength in this mission, let us remember that the word advocate comes from the Latin word *advocatus*, which means "one who draws near." *Come, Holy Spirit, come!*
