

A Message from Jen Rice

DIRECTOR OF MISSION & PASTORAL CARE

Transitions. The idea is heavily on my mind as, by the time you read this, we have left the first triplet at college and the other two are heading out in a few days. I know I am not alone in my feelings of fear and anxiety in transition time – kids are going back to school this week, jobs are changing, perhaps a physical move or even a change in health. The anticipation of

the "What is next?" can keep us up at night and restlessly scattered in our days. We are first human, created by God with emotions also created by Him – all expected and normal (even when it does not feel like it). But there is additional hope and expectation of us because we are His children and we have been given His Spirit within us to cope.

The second reading from Hebrews this Sunday is timed so perfectly for us as a reminder of the "extra" we receive as believers in Christ to handle these transitions and fears:

Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us...

First, we are surrounded by witnesses who have gone before us and those who stand here ready to support us. Who do we have in Heaven cheering us on, ready to intercede for us as we call out in our need? For me it's my grandparents, my godfather and my in-laws, with our Blessed Mother, and some go-to Saints on the front lines. Here on earth, it is our friends, our fellow parishioners who may have already gone through these transitions and can witness to us coming out the other side. Through that earthly and heavenly support, we can shake off the burden of fear and feel more confident in running whatever race we have entered. We need only to ask for help. But there is more: ...while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith.

We have Jesus.

Consider how He endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart.

He has already done it, my friends. Jesus has endured every fear, hurt, worry, and the ultimate transition so He could go before us and lead us through. If you need a reminder, just look at the cross and spend some time in prayer there (our chapel is ideal for this). There He is with outstretched arms waiting for you to hand those emotional burdens into His arms so He can help you carry them. While the emotions may still be strong and the anxiety of the unknown still present, knowing that Jesus is in the midst of it, one step ahead, allows us to persevere so that we do not grow weary and lose heart.

As we move through our life transitions, let us link arms and run together, following Jesus. We can be certain He will stay with us through the whole race.

A Prayer for Students...

We give you praise, O God, for all that is new, all that holds promise & all that brings joy. Bless us as we start this new year at school. May we show love to one another & to all. May the beginning of this school year remind us that You allow us to start over again & again. Help us to forgive others as You forgive us. Help us to learn & to work together. Help us listen when we should, find the best words to speak & know when to be guiet. Help us to be good friends this year. Help us to be patient with ourselves & others. Bless our school & keep us safe. Help us to be aware of Your love, shown to us in the people around us. Bless all who care for us in school & at home. May the Blessed Mother Mary help us live as well as she did, giving all thanks & glory to God. Amen





GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Today's readings acknowledge the real challenges of living our faith. Following Christ will sometimes put us at odds with others – an uncomfortable reality that many will face in our broken and divided world. Yet we can find strength knowing that Jesus understands the constant opposition (both inward and outward) that we face. The second reading says, "Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners." Jesus knows what it's like to face opposition, but he endured it "for the sake of the joy that lay before him." That is our calling too. We are made to know the joy that awaits us beyond our crosses. We find the strength to persevere through our trials by "keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus." Keeping Christ as our focus, we will be able to overcome any obstacle we may face and run toward the goal of heaven.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

In today's Gospel, Jesus said, "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing." Jesus' desire is that the whole world be set aflame with his love, and yet, he knows that this will not come easily. The good news is that Jesus is with us in the midst of the struggle. He too knows the deep longing and even anguish (the Gospel today uses that word!) that we experience as we work so that others may come to know God's love. We can take comfort in the fact that as much as we want to see others come to faith, God desires it even more than we do, and he is also pouring out his grace continually upon us. In the midst of any discouragement we may feel about those who seem opposed to God and to faith, may we remember the burning love that Christ has and his immense desire to draw all people to himself.


