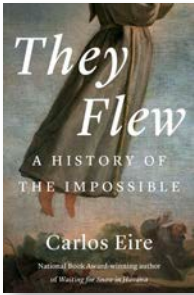

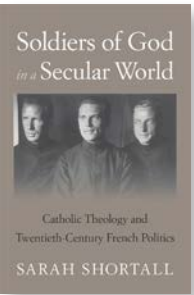
St Brendan Parish Staff End-of-Summer Reading Recommendations...

FATHER SEAN DOOLEY:

A couple months ago, I shared from the pulpit the book entitled: *They Flew: A History of the Impossible* by Carlos Eire. The text covers the fascinating accounts of St. Teresa of Avila, St. Joseph of Cupertino, and some other interesting cases. This is a well-researched text with documentation to when these events of bilocation and levitation occurred centuries ago. The author makes the interesting observation that while Sir Isaac Newton was formulating the theory on gravity, St. Joseph Cupertino was levitating in Italy! A great read on the supernatural in Catholicism.

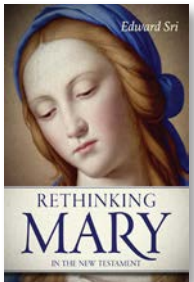


I have a deep interest in 20th century philosophy and theology. I just finished reading *Soldiers of God in a Secular World: Catholic Theology & Twentieth-Century French Politics*. While the topic seems narrowly focused, the author discusses the challenges that the Church faced amidst the rise of Nazism, Communism, and the secularization of society. The horrors of two world wars opened the eyes of theologians who saw the Church has need to address the challenges of humanity. Some of these theological ideas later play out during the Second Vatican Council.



JEN RICE, DIRECTOR OF MISSION & PASTORAL CARE

My small group is reading this very detailed book that focuses on our Blessed Mother in Scripture only: *Rethinking Mary in the New Testament* by Edward Sri. He draws upon his own studies and other scholars' to look closely at each scene where Mary appears and the words that she speaks or are spoken to her, to show the reader just how important she is in our faith. Showing patterns between "annunciations" for example and what sets The Annunciation apart is fascinating. There is now no way you will read or hear these passages again the same way after moving through this deep exploration. I also have found an even stronger appreciation for our Mother and connection to her words and actions.

August Spiritual Spotlight

Saints Monica & Augustine: *Praying for Those Who Are Away from Their Faith*

During August, we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6) and the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15). We recently featured books on Mary and Jesus in our Spiritual Spotlight, so this month, we will provide books that feature St Monica (Feast day: August 27) and St Augustine (Feast day: August 28). When St Monica's son, Augustine, joined the Manichean sect and went astray in faith and morals, Monica's tears and prayers for him were incessant. She followed her son to Milan, where Augustine went to teach, and there continued to storm heaven with her prayers. Finally, she had the joy of witnessing St Ambrose baptize Augustine in 387. Their story illustrates the power of prayer when it comes to bringing those away from their faith back. We will also include books that address this topic that you can take and share with others this month.

Also, please note: The St Monica Prayer Boards are available by the Welcome Desk for you to write the name(s) of any loved ones who have been away from the Church. (Please write each person's name only once.) We will pray for them to return back to their faith at the Inviting Catholics Home event, "**Nothing Is Far from God**" on August 27 (St Monica's Feast Day) with Mass (5:30 PM), Holy Hour with praise and worship (6-7 PM) and a reception with refreshments in the Davidson Rooms (7-8 PM) to end the evening.

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Eccl 1:2; 2:21-23 | Col 3:1-5, 9-11 | Lk 12:13-21

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

A few years ago, I heard this witty but thought-provoking phrase: "You never see a U-Haul attached to a hearse" – a reminder that we don't get to take our physical belongings with us when we die. This phrase came to mind as I read today's Gospel. Jesus offers us a parable about the perils of placing our ultimate hope in amassing possessions. In our own lives, we might be challenged or inspired by the quiet example of people around us who demonstrate that material things aren't what matter most. From individuals who lose their possessions but express gratitude for their physical safety to the child who hears about others in need and gathers up items from their own room to share, we glean gentle reminders that in the end, stuff is just stuff. Pondering this, what we're left with is an invitation from Jesus to look inward: Where are our hearts in relation to our material possessions? Do we cling to them tightly, or do we hold them lightly? What does it mean to be "rich in what matters to God"?

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

The antidote to our disordered attachment to material things is to cultivate Gospel simplicity. In sending his disciples out to spread the Gospel, Jesus often instructed them to "pack light": "Take nothing for the journey, neither walking stick, nor sack, nor food, nor money ..." Jesus told his disciples (Lk 9:3). Instead, they were to go into the surrounding villages and rely on the hospitality of those they encountered to provide for all their needs. By carrying nothing with them, they learned to rely on God's providence and to intentionally reach out to others from a place of vulnerability and humility, both necessary in sharing the Gospel. While we aren't necessarily called to be itinerant preachers as the disciples were, we can take up Jesus' call to "pack light" as we strive to share the Gospel with others in our daily lives.

REFLECT

What can we learn from the disciples about overcoming the temptation to think that we are self-sufficient, as if sharing the Gospel depends entirely on us, rather than his grace? How might we adopt a simpler lifestyle, so that others see in us a living witness to the fact that our hope is not here in this world, but in the life to come? Reflect about how to live Gospel simplicity more intentionally in your life this week, and what that might offer for your efforts to share the Gospel with others.



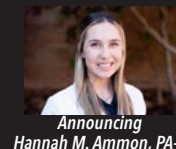
