Hello Saint Brendan Parish Family,

My name is Shawn Ryan Caslow, Jr. I grew up in Columbus and am the oldest of three boys. Life was not easy for my family. My father worked long hours to provide for us, and my mother stayed home to raise us. We were never wealthy, but our lives were simple and good. Faith was never a part of my family – we never talked about God, and we had a Pocket Bible that lived in a drawer, never to be pulled out.

My parents did see the good in Christian values and my brothers and I had attended a nondenominational church with my grandmother, but my parents never went to church with us. By the time I reached middle school, I was beginning to be swept up in the culture, and my home life took a turn for the worse. I stopped attending church and became an atheist. In my high school years, my parents had separated, and we moved out of my childhood home. During that time, my father, brothers and I moved three different times and so, I had attended three different high schools. I graduated from Dublin Coffman in 2015 and then attended Columbus State for two years. In 2017 I transferred to Ohio State and began to study Criminology and Criminal Justice.

During my time at Ohio State, I met a girl who brought me with her to the Newman Center for Mass. I received all my sacraments on the Easter Vigil of 2019. After entering the Church, I dropped out of college and began working. Since I lived near downtown, I had started attending church at St Patrick's and continued to work for two years.

During COVID, I had decided to enter the Seminary and so, in 2021 entered a religious community, but quickly discerned that the Lord wasn't calling me to that spiritual life. I left that congregation in 2022 and joined the Diocese of Columbus, beginning my formation at a seminary in Philadelphia for a Spiritual Year (a year of preparation). After finishing my Spiritual Year, I came home to start my academic formation at the Josephinum and have been here since 2023. I will graduate with a philosophy degree in the spring and then will attend Mount Saint Mary's in Cincinnati for my theological studies.

I registered here at St Brendan's because I have lived within the parish boundaries for over a decade. Simply put, the Dublin/Hillard area is the place I consider to be home. Know that I am praying for you all as I begin this new year of formation. Please keep me in your prayers. I will be around during breaks, so please say hello if you see me. I look forward to meeting you in person!

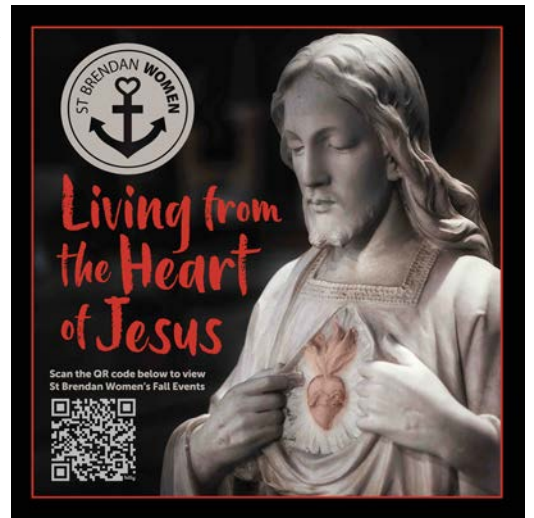



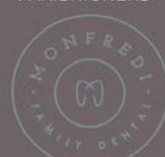
