A Message from Fr Severance

Hello St Brendan! I hope you all are doing well these days! Speaking for myself, things are going well. I am really starting to feel acclimated at the parish. Throughout these first few months of my priesthood, I have seen in both big and small ways, the life within the parish here at St Brendan – a life which is very beautiful! Thank you for allowing me to be a part of the family, as well as for your hospitality and help through these first few months.

One of the prominent features in my life of prayer at this moment is the Rosary. This is largely the result of the month of October being dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary (also known as "Our Lady of Victory") which commemorates a battle that took place on October 7, 1571 between the Holy League and the Ottoman Empire. This battle is known as the Battle of Lepanto (which is near modern-day Greece). Furthermore, it was Pope Pius V, fearing Ottoman defeat, who instructed the worldwide Church to pray the Rosary with the intention that the Holy League defeat the Ottoman Empire, who at the time, was much stronger than the Holy League. To the shock of the world, the small naval fleet of the Holy League defeated the much larger naval fleet of the Ottoman Empire. It was truly a miracle! A miracle that occurred through the intercession of Our Lady, who we now know as Our Lady of the Rosary or Our Lady of Victory!

I think there is a connection between this historical event and our own spiritual lives. Like the Holy League, we too, face many challenges, obstacles, and problems. While these problems are different for everyone, we are united in our need for help, prayers, and support. I think this month of October is a fantastic chance for us, like the Holy League in 1571, to turn toward Our Lady for her intercession. This is especially true in those areas of our lives where we feel particularly uneasy about certain circumstances.

If you are able to relate to these words, this is your sign to reach to Our Lady. She, who is our mother, desires to help us on the journey to eternal life and this month in particular, we should allow her to do so in an amplified way. We should take all of our worries, battles, and anxieties and give them to our Blessed Mother, who desires to help us encounter not only her love, but the love of her Son, Jesus.

May I suggest praying a Rosary as a family this month in honor of Our Lady? If an entire Rosary feels like too much, maybe a decade would be better. Choosing one of these options is a sure way for your family to be together, to pray together, and to ask Our Lady for her intercession. May your family, especially this month of Our Lady of the Rosary, feel close to Our Lady and protected by her who was given to us by Christ on the cross as our mother. ***Our Lady of the Rosary, pray for us!***

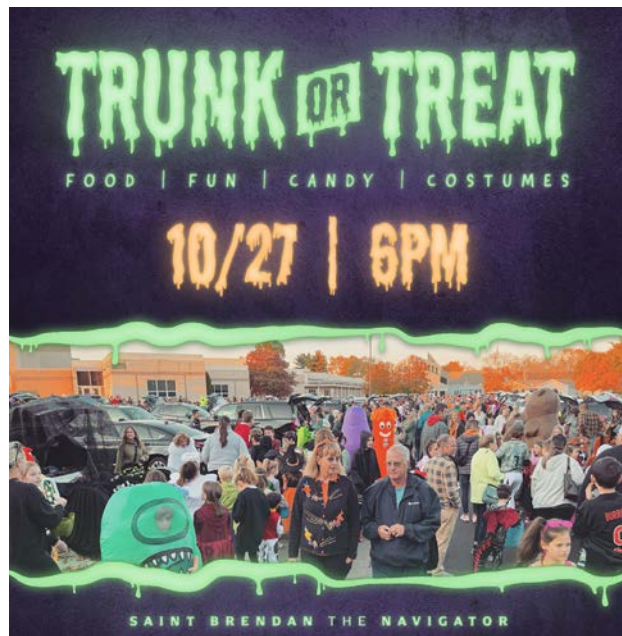

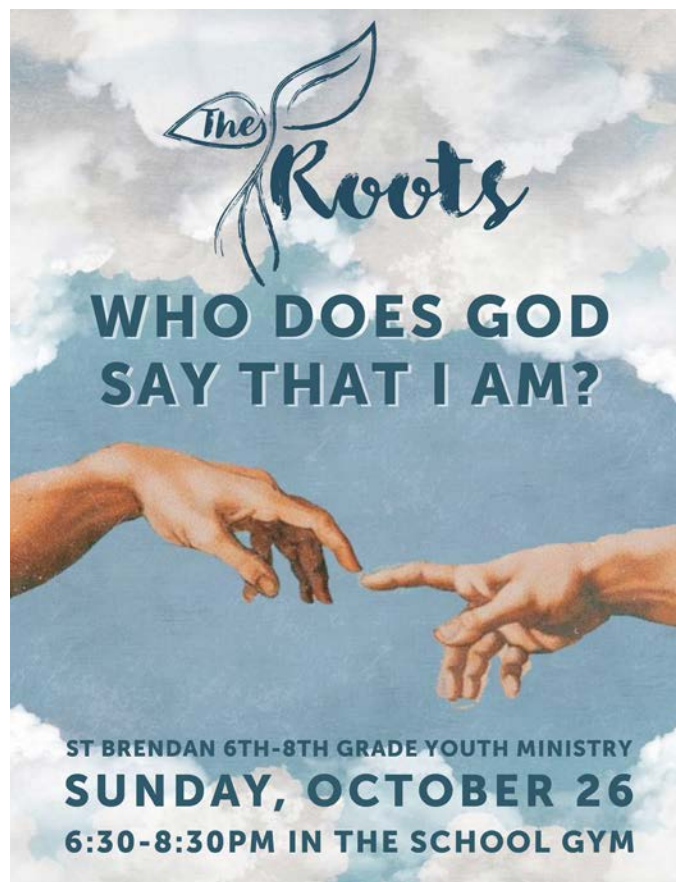

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Studying Scripture is not a side dish on the plate of practicing the faith. It is an essential component of the virtuous life, and without it, our faith will surely falter. In his second letter to Timothy, Saint Paul reminds us that the Scriptures are the inspired Word of God and they train us in righteous living and equip us for every good work. There will undoubtedly be times when we feel ill-equipped – when we are fatigued, frustrated, or concerned. It is precisely in these moments that we're invited to go quickly to the holy Word of God! Read it, pray with it, and invite the Spirit to speak to you through it. There you will find the wisdom needed to face every circumstance.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our faith journey was never meant to be a solitary endeavor! We see this in today's first reading when Aaron and Hur stand beside Moses, holding his weary arms in the air as the battle rages on against the Amalekites. This image of the three men on the mountain – Moses with his arms raised high, Aaron and Hur on either side supporting them – is a powerful image of companionship in the Christian life. When you feel too weary to pray, look around – the Lord has likely given you companions who can support you precisely in the ways you need at this time. Pay attention, too, to who God might be inviting you to support in prayer. Our Gospel tells us that God always hears our prayer and calls us to be persistent in prayer. Certainly, God will "secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." God calls us to persist in prayer because it reveals our faith and trust in him that we constantly bring our needs before him.

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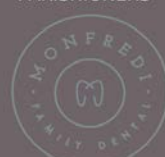


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
