St Vincent de Paul Society 2025 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the Scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

Currently, there are 22 full members and 35 associate members of St Brendan's St Vincent de Paul Society. During the Fiscal Year Oct 1, 2024–Sept 30, 2025, members responded to 199 calls for assistance. Parishioners' monetary and "in kind" donations enabled St Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest parts of the diocese.

WORKS OF MERCY

Total Dollars Spent: \$74,803.25

Total Volunteer Hours: 1,208

Feed the Hungry/Give Drink to the Thirsty:

- St Lawrence Haven: \$1,000
Sandwich Supplies: \$5,508 (to make over 16,000 sandwiches for Holy Family and St Lawrence Haven)
- Hilliard Food Pantry: 5,362 pounds of food donated in our Green Bin
- 2025 Thanksgiving in June Food Drive: 3,562 pounds to Hilliard Food Pantry
- Donations to the Hilliard Food Pantry provided over 10,700 meals

Shelter the Homeless/Clothe the Naked:

- Rent, Utility, Clothing, Car Expenses: \$54,890 helped 230+ neighbors in need
- St Lawrence Haven and other SVDP conferences: \$12,075
- Collaboration with Joint Organization for Inner-City Needs: \$1,200
- St Vincent de Paul Thrift Store Donation Drive: 300+ parishioners donated gently used clothes and household items filling 3 trailers and a box truck

Visit the Sick/Comfort the Afflicted:

- Blessing Bags: prepared/distributed 100 bags with toiletries to the homeless
- Gifts and Visits through Giving Tree for the needy at Christmas
- SVDP Prayer Ministry prayed for 30 straight days for each neighbor we serve.

A Note of Thanks from Kairos Prison Ministry

Kairos Prison Ministry is grateful for the 500+ dozen cookies our parishioners donated and enough money to provide meals for the residence and volunteers. The prayer chain links made a garland filled with notes of hope that went around the room two times! Many participants left heartfelt responses to their Kairos weekend at London Correctional Institute experience. Read some below:

I needed fellowship and I got it. Thanks be to God for a weekend with good people. Thanks for the tools to be able to walk with God the rest of our life. God gave me so much this weekend. I must share it to others in the prison.

Kairos is truly amazing! I was on a dark path of depression and unforgiveness and was led to Kairos by a friend. Thanks be to God! I learned a lot and plan to use it. I feel so good and blessed, even being in prison. I never felt so much love.

Many of my family members are dead because of my sin and addiction. I stand here sober and have the courage to change myself. I came to grow spiritually and am.

I found a new family inside these walls. I came to Kairos seeking Hope. I was lost, damaged, confused and abandoned but today am filled with optimism and hope. I had a change of heart and now have the tools to get closer to God.

After 44 years in prison, today I felt freedom in these walls. I'm overwhelmed with joy and grace. What a surprise to experience this feeling of love in prison.

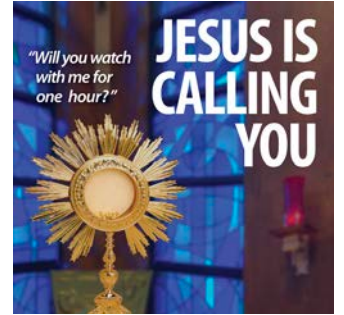
2025 Christmas Giving Trees

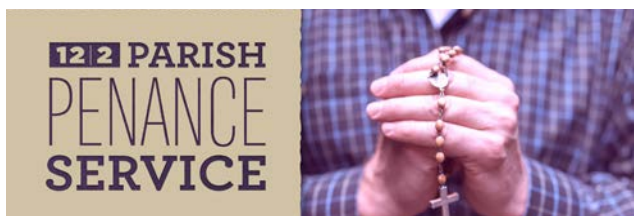
Advent by Candlelight, Dec 5

Updated Safe Environment Policies for Volunteers...

The Diocese of Columbus recently updated new policies regarding *Safe Environment* to strengthen protection for children, youth and vulnerable adults across our diocese. These new policies include:

- **Background checks and VIRTUS training** must be completed before beginning any service involving minors, **with renewals every 5 years**. If you have had a background check completed but have not been actively volunteering with children for **more than 18 months**, you must have your background check updated, even if your initial background check is less than 5 years old.
- **Reinforcement of the Two-Deep Policy**, requiring that no adult is ever alone with a minor, and maintaining proper adult-to-minor supervision ratios for all activities.
- **When both male and female minors are present**, there must be at least **one male and one female volunteer**. This ensures appropriate boundaries and comfort for all participants.
