A Message from Fr Severance

Happy New Year, St Brendan Parish! As many of you already know, the first Sunday in Advent marks the beginning of our Church’s liturgical calendar. Praise God for another year in the books and for another year ahead of us!

Speaking for myself, I love this time of year with the anticipation of Christmas and the festivities leading up to Christmas. Some of the best advice I received regarding this time of year was while in seminary from the rector at the Pontifical College Josephinum, Fr Steven Beseau. He encouraged us to celebrate the season of Advent in full rather than skip over Advent like most do in the rest of the world. Admittedly, this was hard to hear, as Christmas is my favorite. His advice, however, has been very beneficial to my spiritual life, and I will explain why.

The season of Advent is a season of waiting, in which we wait in anticipation for the coming of the Lord. The coming of the Lord is twofold. The season of Advent first invites us to ponder the coming of the Lord at the end of time. Secondly, the season of Advent invites us to anticipate the coming of the Lord at the Nativity. This twofold meaning of Advent helps us to realize that we both need a savior in Christ Jesus, and that He is coming to establish His kingdom on this earth.

The reason this is important for our spiritual lives is that it emphasizes our need for a savior. The Israelites were waiting for a savior for over 3,000 years! They knew they needed a messiah, someone who would fulfill the promises of God. However, generation after generation would pass without a savior (and we think just four weeks during Advent is a long time to wait!). In realizing this, Advent helps us to participate in what the Israelites experienced as they lived for so many years in constant waiting for their savior.

Now, here is the best part: When the Savior finally arrives, it's time to party! And this is why taking the season of Advent seriously is important for our spiritual lives – when we participate fully in the anticipation of the Lord, when we yearn for the coming of our Savior in the same way the Israelites did for so many years, the celebration of His arrival is just that much more celebratory when it does finally take place on Christmas Day.

Let us, therefore, enter more fully into this great season of Advent this year here at St Brendan. One great opportunity to celebrate Advent more fully this year will take place in our church on December 10 at 6:30 AM during a “Rorate Mass.”

A Rorate Mass is a special Mass, only celebrated during the season of Advent, where the church is lit only by candlelight and there is a special focus placed on the Blessed Virgin Mary, her consent to be the Mother of God, and the anticipation of the arrival of her Son at the Nativity. This Mass is a beautiful way to celebrate the great season of Advent. Please come and join us for our Rorate Mass on December 10 at 6:30 AM. You will not regret it!

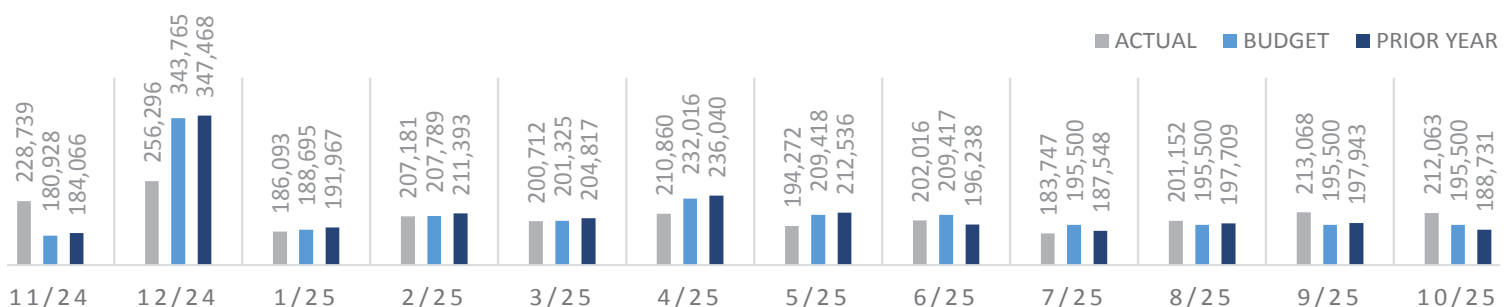

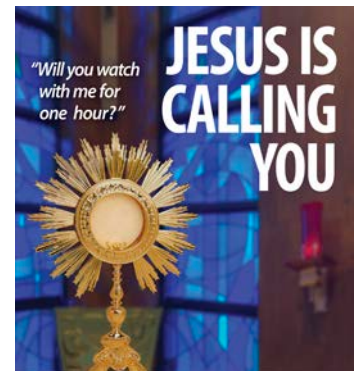
Feed the Hungry "Mac & Cheese" Dec 14

Safe Environment Compliance Update

As we continue our commitment to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all children and vulnerable persons, the Diocese of Columbus has updated Safe Environment requirements. All volunteers are asked to be fully compliant with Protecting God's Children training and complete the required background checks by January 2, 2026. To meet diocesan policy, the following background checks are required for volunteers:

- **BCI (Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation) background check** is required for all volunteers.
- In addition to BCI, **FBI background check** is required for volunteers who have lived outside the state of Ohio during the past 5 years.
- If you currently volunteer, we encourage you to **check that your VIRTUS account is active and up to date**, and that your background check has been completed within the required 5-year timeframe.
- **Reinforcement of the Two-Deep Policy**, requiring that no adult is ever alone with a minor, and maintaining proper adult-to-minor supervision ratios for all activities.
- **For offsite or overnight activities, when both male and female minors are present**, there must be at least one male and one female volunteer to ensure appropriate comfort for all participants.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

For many in the upper latitudes of the northern hemisphere, this is the darkest time of the year, the time when the duration of daylight is at its lowest. It's providential, then, that our first reading calls us to "walk in the light of the Lord!" Paul tells us that we do this by "throw[ing] off the works of darkness" and "put[ting] on the armor of light." While we might not struggle with the vices listed in Paul's Letter to the Romans, each of us has our own struggles against sin. As we begin this Advent season, let us take time to do a thorough examination of conscience to discern areas of weakness and sin – those "works of darkness" Paul talks about – in our own lives. Then, consider taking up practices that help you to foster the opposing virtues to arm yourself against these temptations. As you grow in these virtues, you'll certainly be on your way up the mountain of the Lord and walking in his light!

PRAY

Take a moment to pray this week for those "divine appointments" – those individuals who might come your way – seeking encouragement or insight into the spiritual questions in their lives. Ask for the grace to be "awake" so that you're ready to meet them when they come. We can't always predict when these encounters will happen, but we can prepare ourselves to receive these persons as Christ and offer them our full attention and love.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Today's Gospel calls us to vigilance. Jesus tells us, "Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come." While he is speaking about our need to be ready to meet the Lord when he comes at the end of our lives, it's also an invitation for us to always be ready to share our faith with others whenever the opportunity presents itself. As Scripture says, we should "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you a reason for your hope." (1 Pet 3:15) We never know the moment when someone will come to us in need of prayer, a word of encouragement, or with questions related to their own spiritual hunger. We must always be ready to meet them where they are and offer a word of hope.

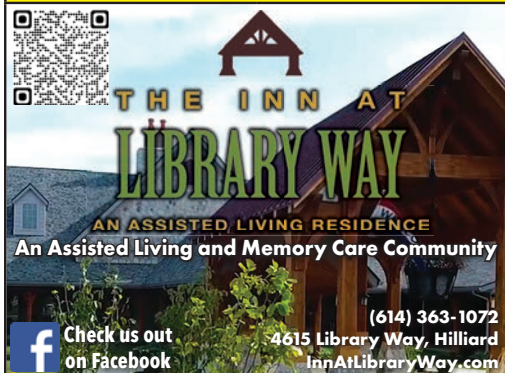

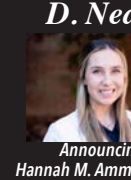
