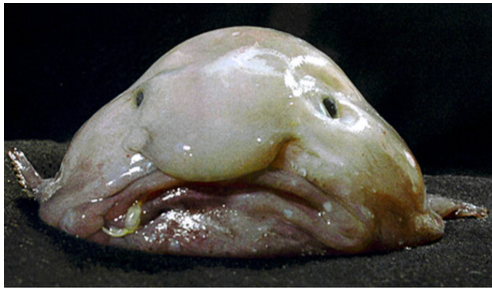

Message from Annie Johanni



Have you ever looked at a blobfish and thought: maybe God DOES make mistakes?

Well, obviously, He is perfect, and doesn't. The hilariously misshapen face of a blobfish we

see is actually the result of rapid depressurization that occurs when the fish is pulled from the black depths that it lives in. Blobfish spend their entire lives well below the midnight zone of the ocean, experiencing no light and up to 100 times the pressure that we do on earth's surface. If, instead of snatching it from its dwelling place, we visited it there, it would look quite normal.

So why am I talking about an ugly and niche aquatic creature? Because I think we have something to learn from it concerning prayer.

Stick with me...

God has revealed Himself to us in many ways – through creation, the Word, the Church, and perhaps most wonderfully, Jesus. But He still remains hidden in a key location: our souls.

It is a strange phenomenon that the Trinity dwells so intimately within baptized persons, yet we often rarely notice His presence. St John of the Cross beautifully explains why this is the case:

"How is it, then, that I find Him not, nor feel Him, if He is within my soul? It is because He is hidden, and because you hide not yourself also that you may find Him and feel Him; for he that will seek that which is hidden must enter secretly into the secret place where it is hidden, and when he finds it, he is himself hidden like the object of his search."

Like the blobfish, we ought to **seek Him** in the place where He has chosen to dwell, unencumbered by the lights and pressures of this world that can distort His face to us. So, we too must be hidden.

Jesus Himself demonstrated how to enter into this hidden prayer as we read in Mark that "Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house, and went off to a lonely place to pray."

My encouragement for us is that we would all attempt to hide ourselves away with the hidden Jesus this week, that we would find a secret place, perhaps even a dark place, to pray and to look inward at our lovely Lord who dwells within us.

Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome

Ez 47:1-2, 8-9, 12 | 1 Cor 3:9c-11, 16-17 | Jn 2:13-22

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GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Although today's feast marks the dedication of one of the most important churches for Catholics, the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, it's ultimately not a celebration of a building, but a celebration of all members of the Church. As Paul reminds us, we are "the temple of God" and the Spirit of God dwells in us. We see in the Gospel that Jesus has immense love for the temple and wishes to protect it. He uses a whip made from cords to drive out the money-changers, telling them, "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace." So, too, he loves and cherishes his Body, the Church – the place his presence dwells. Today's feast invites us to consider our love and zeal for the Church. As our love for the Lord grows, we will grow to love what our Savior loves.

PRAY

At every Mass, during the Prayer of the Faithful, we pray for the needs of the Church first. This is intentional – as the Church is the Bride of Christ. Pay particular attention to what we pray at this moment and consider how you can show your love for the Church by praying for her and for the needs of the Church throughout the world in your personal prayer this week.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Our first reading offers a beautiful image that can help us understand our mission as disciples. The prophet Ezekiel has a vision of the temple with water flowing out of it. Wherever the water flowed, there was abundant life, including "every sort of living creature," "abundant fish," and "fruit trees of every kind" whose "leaves shall not fade, nor the fruit fail." Since we are God's temple, Ezekiel's vision invites us to be sources of life-giving water, nourishment, and healing for the world around us. A powerful way to evangelize is simply to strive to be conduits of goodness in the world, right where we are. When others are lost in desolation, how can we offer a drink to quench their spiritual thirst? When people around us are hungry, how can we offer physical or spiritual food to ease their hunger? Where there is division, how do we bring healing and hope? Through these actions, we give others a taste of the goodness that life with God offers.

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
