Message from Fr Dooley

I wanted to share with you an announcement regarding our parish community in case you did not hear the announcement last weekend. Bishop Fernandes and the Priest Personnel Board have asked me to take a new assignment in the Diocese of Columbus – to be the Pastor of Our Lady Queen of the Apostles Parish in Chillicothe and Waverly. The assignment begins February 13, 2026.

The reasons for this quick timeline are many, but let me mention a few. Currently, the administrator of the southern parishes is a retired priest, he's 86 years old. He stepped in to help temporarily, but the parish needs stability which comes from having a pastor. Bishop Fernandes has asked me to step in. Many of you know Chillicothe and Waverly was my first assignment as a priest from 2015-2019. In a way, it will be a homecoming for me. We, priests, go where the Bishop needs us to support the clergy and laity. I know that my brother priests would do the same for me.

Fr Michael Lumpe, whom many of you may know, will be the new pastor at St Brendan. Fr Lumpe brings plenty of leadership and expertise to our parish – Please read his bio down below.

Although my time here has been short, it has been an honor being your pastor. While it is not goodbye yet, please pray for Fr Lumpe, for me, and for the good people of Hilliard, Chillicothe and Waverly. Let us continue to pray for one another and our parish. Thank you for all that you have done since my arrival in 2024. I look forward to spending Advent and Christmas with you as your pastor.

A Note About Fr Michael Lumpe...

Fr Michael Lumpe – "Fr Mike" – was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Columbus in 2004 by Bishop James Griffin. His first assignment was associate pastor at Saint Matthew Parish in Gahanna.

Since then, Fr Mike has served as Pastor of Christ the King Parish, Pastor of St Catharine of Siena Parish, Rector of St Joseph Cathedral and Pastor of Holy Cross Church, Vice Rector - Pontifical College Josephinum, and Pastor of St Michael Parish. During these assignments, Fr Mike was a founding member of the Bishop Griffin Center, served as J.O.I.N. Chaplain, served for 10 years as the Diocesan Vicar for Priests, served on the St Charles Preparatory School Advisory Board (he is a St Charles alum, Class of 1978), and served on the Catholic Foundation Advisory Board. He presently serves as Diocesan Vicar for Hospital Ministry, working with the four major hospital systems in Franklin County to ensure proactive ministry to Catholic patients by our small army of Catholic Priest Chaplains. Fr Mike also serves as Diocesan Vicar for Senior and Infirm Priests, seeing to the health and well-being of our Priests, and ensuring the needs of our Senior and Retired Priests are met; these duties tandem well with his assignment as Chaplain of the Villas at St Therese and Mother Angeline McCrory Manor.

Fr Mike is looking forward to serving all the people who make St Brendan's their home, journeying together as we follow our Savior, Jesus Christ, as "*doers of the word, not hearers only*" (James 1:22).

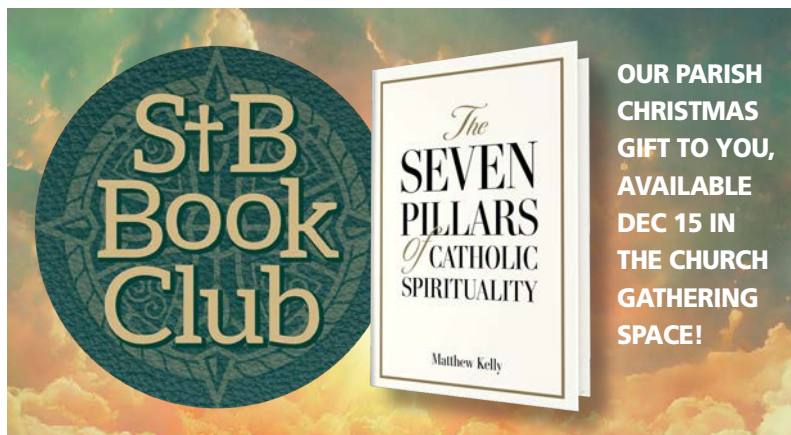

Is 35:1-6a, 10 | Jas 5:7-10 | Mt 11:2-11

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

One morning, I woke up feeling exhausted after a fitful night of sleep. I was achy and generally under the weather. Despite this, I made a to-do list because the day's work still needed to be accomplished. I was determined to not let this sickness interrupt my productivity, even though I *knew* I needed to rest. It occurred to me, then, that rest — and dependence on others and God — is sacred also. In today's psalm, we hear of the many ways the Lord provides: The *Lord* gives, the *Lord* raises, the *Lord* loves, the *Lord* protects, the *Lord* saves. We cannot accomplish our own salvation, but we can rest in the promise the Lord provides, and we can hope in the salvation offered in Christ. As we wait in joyful anticipation for the coming of Jesus at Christmas, let us find time to rest in his Word and his presence, trusting that our salvation does not depend on us and has already come to fruition in Christ.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

As we saw in our psalm, God is the one who takes initiative, who provides for our salvation. In our work to share the faith with others, sometimes our task is simply to help others become aware of the ways God is providing for them by pointing out the signs of his action in their lives. When the disciples of John came to Jesus asking if he was "the one who is to come" or whether they should "look for another," Jesus reminds them of the evidence all around them: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, and the dead are raised. As we help others to see God's work in their lives, we are also leading them to greater faith and trust in him.
