# Message from Fr Weldit

## BREATHING WITH THE TWO LUNGS OF THE CHURCH

At St Brendan's, I am blessed to serve in both the Latin Rite and the Eastern Rite of the Catholic Church. In this way, I truly experience what the Church often describes as "breathing with two lungs," sharing in the richness of both traditions and liturgical languages. Some people may know only one rite, but through the welcoming spirit of the St Brendan community and the Eritrean community, I have learned how to breathe deeply with both lungs of the Church. This experience has been a great joy for me.

Being part of St Brendan Parish is truly a blessing. I am continually moved by the faith, kindness, and generosity of this community. Here, different traditions come together in unity, love, and respect, beautifully reflecting the universal nature of the Catholic Church.

As we know, the celebration of Christmas is observed on two different dates: December 25 in the Roman (Latin) Rite and January 7 in the Eastern Rite. As members of the Eritrean community following the Eastern Rite, we joyfully celebrated the Nativity of our Lord on January 7. Although the dates and liturgical expressions differ, the mystery we celebrate is the same—the birth of Jesus Christ, our Savior. In both rites, we rejoiced together in the beauty, prayer, and joy of Christ's coming into the world.

Throughout the history of the people of Israel, God spoke through many individuals—Abraham, Moses, Elijah, and the prophets. God sent messengers to guide His people and to call them back to Him. But when the fullness of time came, God chose a new and final way to speak to humanity: He sent His only Son. In Jesus, God no longer speaks only through messengers but comes to dwell among us.

This mystery continues in the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. In the Latin Rite, we have recently celebrated this feast, and in the Eritrean Eastern tradition, we will celebrate it on January 19. At His baptism in the Jordan, Jesus begins His public ministry. The Father's voice is heard, the Holy Spirit descends, and Jesus is revealed to the world as the beloved Son. From this moment, Christ begins to speak directly to His people, inviting all to repentance, faith, and new life.

The Baptism of the Lord reminds us that the message of Christmas does not end at the manger. The Child born in Bethlehem is the Son who steps into the waters of the Jordan to sanctify them and to call us into a deeper relationship with God. Through Him, we are invited to listen, to pray, and to speak to the Father with our own hearts.

**This is the heart of our Christmas message in both rites:**


*God is with us.*

*God speaks to us through His Son.*

*God listens to us with love.*

May the celebration of Christmas and the Baptism of the Lord in both the Latin and Eastern traditions deepen our unity, strengthen our faith, and help us rejoice together in the one Lord who is born for us and who calls us to follow Him.

## Nefasit Tutoring Initiative

As many of you know, Father Weldit hails from Eritrea on the eastern "Horn of Africa." While Father deeply admires his home, the nation faces many challenges. Since 1995, the government has prohibited religious groups from providing social services — and has seized Catholic schools and hospitals. As Catholic bishops in Eritrea have publicly decried these hostile seizures, the government has only tightened its grip. Out of 180 countries, The World Press Freedom Index ranks Eritrea dead last in press freedom and censorship.

As access to healthcare and education standards suffer, Catholic leaders in Eritrea seek creative ways to grow awareness and support their people regardless of religious affiliation, political beliefs, or race. The Auxiliary Sisters' Institute — an order of nuns founded and based in Eritrea — have a personal relationship with Fr Weldit. The Mother General, Natsenet Embaye, has asked Fr Weldit for assistance in raising \$5,000 to establish a tutoring program for 15 schoolchildren in the town of Nefasit, Eritrea. She shared a corresponding budget which includes essential supplies, textbooks, whiteboards, maps, science kits and stipends for tutors.



The religious sisters would oversee all operations in Nefasit to ensure successful outcomes for the children. To quote Sister Natsenet, "The requested \$5,000 will create lasting educational impact and strengthen the Sisters' ongoing mission of service."

Here at St Brendan, this homegrown initiative is a powerful way for our parish to stand in solidarity with the global Church and to support young people whose futures depend on education. 


