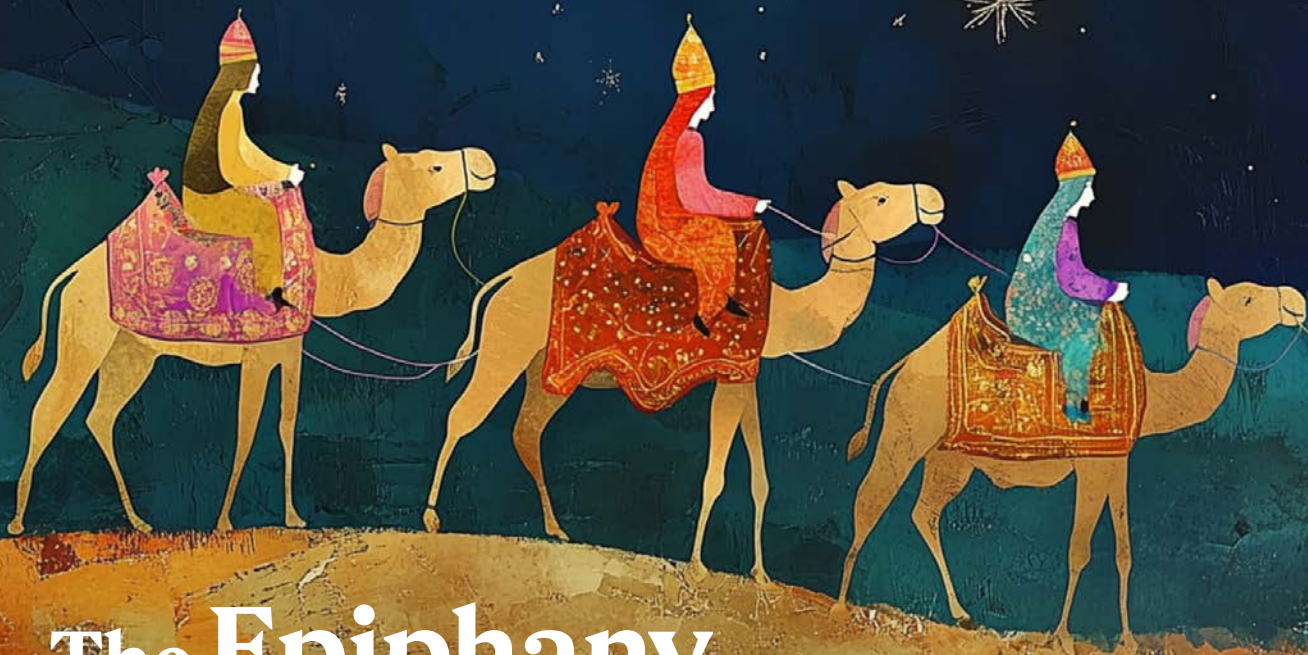

January

Message from Wendy Ferkany

"O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament divine, all praise and all thanksgiving, be forever thine!" In my work as Adult Evangelization Coordinator, specifically in my role as facilitator of the OCIA program, I think of this hymn a lot. Just this past month, we were blessed at St Brendan to have eight adults receive sacraments at the Feast of the Immaculate Conception Mass. There were four Baptisms, eight Confirmations and eight First Holy Communions received that night! We don't applaud regularly during Mass, but that night, the applause was long and heartfelt!



Do you remember receiving your sacraments? If you received them as a child, it may have been long ago. Before receiving a sacrament, there is a period of education (catechism) that takes place. Of course, an infant's parents receive the instruction before their child's Baptism, but for the others, it is the recipient that receives the instruction.

What is so important about sacraments? Are they just a nice ceremony to show that you have faith in Jesus Christ? They are so much more than that! The purpose of being catechized for a sacrament is to ensure that the participant understands the profound meanings, commitments, and spiritual realities involved, in order to transform it from a mere ritual into lived faith in Jesus' teachings.

In our Catholic faith, sacraments serve to impart grace, through God's power and to strengthen us in our life's journey. Just as the Eucharist begins with ordinary elements of bread and wine, all sacraments begin with human elements like water, oil, words and gestures. Why is this? God uses human elements in the sacraments because humans learn through their senses. Jesus, being both divine and human, used physical means to convey spiritual realities. The invisible grace of God becomes visible and tangible through ordinary things, connecting with our embodied nature to transform us. These physical elements paired with specific words become a channel of God's grace, continuing Christ's saving work and making the divine present in our earthly lives.

Has it been a while since you've received your sacraments? Have you forgotten the meaning behind them? Helping with an OCIA cohort or becoming someone's sponsor is a great way to serve newcomers to our faith. As a bonus, you get to review the meanings behind what we do as Catholics to bolster your faith and deepen your relationship with God.

We offer OCIA three times a year now, which means we need three separate cohort teams to facilitate each group. Our first two cohorts, receiving sacraments at Immaculate Conception and Easter Vigils, are currently up and running with amazing leaders. Could God be calling you to join the team for the Assumption cohort? The need exists for those who will step up to help out! We will meet on Tuesday nights, 7-8:30 PM beginning early February through August. Some ways to help include: hospitality servers, table leaders, sponsors and presenters.

Please prayerfully consider joining this special ministry! Contact me, Wendy Ferkany at wferkany@stbrendans.net if you feel a tug in your heart and mind (the Holy Spirit) calling you to fill this important need!

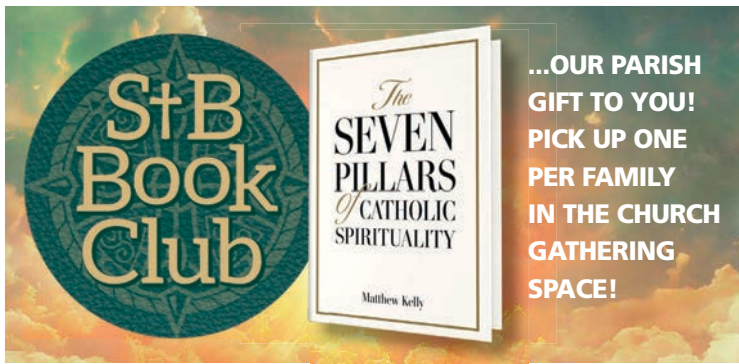

Pastoral Associate Needed

St Brendan's Pastoral Associate for the Ministry of Care and Consolation is responsible for planning, administering and directing the ministry of care and consolation to the parish and its community. This person assists the Pastor, parish staff, coordinators and volunteers to develop effective pastoral care programs/processes for those needing pastoral care and consolation in time of need.

Full-time job duties include: Coordinate pastoral care to the homebound facilities, liaison with nursing facilities, make pastoral visits as needed, staff liaison for funeral Masses/services/volunteers, offer programs related to care and consolation, provide pastoral support to parishioners in emotional/spiritual need or refer them to further services as needed, staff liaison to ministries related to care and consolation, assist in efforts of outreach to the poor and within the Hilliard community, and update content to parish website/bulletin/social media for areas of responsibility.

The Epiphany of the Lord

Is 60:1-6 | Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6 | Mt 2:1-12

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Have you ever had a moment where you've been so joyful that your heart "throbbed and overflowed"? (Is. 60:5) Perhaps this prompt might call to mind moments we have been chosen or noticed, especially when we otherwise felt sidelined or forgotten. (Imagine expecting to be picked last for the team, only to be someone's first choice!) Today's first reading speaks of a moment like that. While the nations of the earth are shrouded in darkness, God shines his light and glory on Jerusalem, and all the nations come streaming to her bearing precious tributes. Similarly, our Gospel speaks about how God chose Bethlehem — a seemingly insignificant town — to be the birthplace of his Son: "And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people." Like Jerusalem and Bethlehem, we, too, have been chosen by God. As we continue our celebration of Christmas, our hearts are filled to overflowing when we recall that by taking on our flesh, God has chosen to make his home with us for all eternity.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

Paul reminds us that God has chosen us, not only for ourselves, but for the sake of others: "You have heard of the stewardship of *God's grace that was given to me for your benefit.*" God gives Paul a special revelation to know the mystery of God so he could preach the Gospel to the Gentiles and to all peoples. We who know the joy of having been chosen to be God's beloved sons and daughters have the beautiful task of helping others to know that they, too, are chosen by God. Because of this, evangelization is not simply an item on our spiritual to-do list; it is a work of joy — helping others to discover their own "belovedness" as children of God. And of course, this message is for *everyone!*

INVITATION

One of the best presents we can offer to someone is our presence. Make an effort this week to intentionally spend time with someone who may feel lonely or forgotten, setting aside other tasks to focus entirely on them. The goal is to help them feel special and *chosen* as a way of giving a glimpse of God's love that chooses each of us out of the many. May the gift of your presence help them to remember how very loved they are.

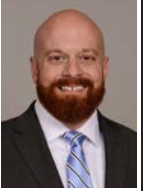
