Why Register at St. Brendan?

The word "parish" comes from the Greek word "paroikia" meaning "a pilgrim people," a people on a journey of faith. At St. Brendan, we are here to support that journey of faith as we walk toward the fullness of life in God's Kingdom forever. We yearn to be in relationship with our parishioners, and like all healthy relationships, a mutual commitment of shared expectations is required for fruitful growth.

If you've been attending St. Brendan for a while (or even since childhood), please confirm that you are a registered adult member of the parish. Young adults fall off their parents' registration at age 22 and are asked to complete their own registration. If you moved out of the area and returned, please re-register. No matter your age or method of discovering St. Brendan, you can easily check your status on ParishStaQ or contact the parish office.

To be a full, "active" parishioner of St. Brendan, you must: Submit an application and pledge form, attend Mass faithfully on Sundays and Holy Days, and share your gifts of time, talent, and treasure with the parish.

Each member is called to understand our tithing responsibilities as Christian stewards of God's blessings to us and commit to sharing them with a grateful heart.

Examples of supporting the parish include: Regular financial giving through envelopes or electronic giving; Participate in ministry with regular attendance; or, Donate your time or talent to support church ministries.

These guidelines are not intended to be restrictive or punitive. Rather, they are a means to help us live the fullness of our Catholic identity as we strive to build up a healthy, thriving parish community.

We look forward to having you join our parish family!

Top Reasons to Register:

Registration creates a sense of belonging and identity.

Registration shows a commitment to practice your faith.

Registration enables the parish pastor and staff to get to know you better, to welcome you and to minister to you, especially during crisis situations.

Registration helps you stay connected with your parish and helps your parish stay connected with you.

Registered members are eligible for sponsor/godparent validation which includes a signed letter from our priest.

Registered active members may be eligible to use or rent parish facilities for sacramental celebrations.

Census numbers determine how many priests are assigned to a parish, the number of Masses needed, and our calculated Bishop's Annual Appeal goal. Therefore, having an accurate count of parishioners is imperative for planning purposes.

There are so many good reasons to be a part of our faith community.

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
